

**JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS**

**KIAMESHA LAKE, N. Y.** -- The United Synagogue of America, the association of Conservative congregations, has resolved to mark the Bicentennial of American independence to show "the special meaning of America to Jews" and the "Jewish stake in a strong democratic system." We urge all of our congregations to devote the Bicentennial year to meaningful study of the mutual relationship between America and its Jewish citizens and the relationship between American ideals and the Jewish heritage.

**NEW YORK (WNS)** -- The B'nai B'rith Anti-Defamation League has reported that the Venezuelan Ministry of Foreign Affairs has rejected a request by the Palestine Liberation Organization that it be allowed to open an office in Caracas.

**JERUSALEM (WNS)** -- Agudath MK Yehuda Meir Abramowitz has introduced a bill into the Knesset to bar law suits against synagogues located in residential buildings.

**JERUSALEM (WNS)** -- Rather than stand guard duty as demanded by the Student Union, eight Arab students have left the Hebrew University campus at Ein Karem.

**LONDON (WNS)** -- Uri Gordon, head of the World Zionist Organization's young leadership department, told a meeting of young British Zionists, that organized Zionism has failed to cope with the present crisis in world Jewry.

**NEW YORK (WNS)** -- President Ford has signed an executive order making it easier for American firms to locate industrial plants in Israel. The Government of Israel Investment Authority said the order means that more than 2700 products manufacturers in Israel can now be imported into the United States duty-free.

**NEW YORK (WNS)** -- Abram Salomon, the executive vice-president of the Jewish National Fund, has announced that 37 U.S. Senators and 13 Governors have joined the National Committee for the American Bicentennial National Park being build by the JNF in the Judean mountains southwest of Jerusalem.

**CLEVELAND (WNS)** -- A resolution urging Israel to "take the initiative" in finding a solution to the Palestinian question, including meeting with the Palestinian Liberation Organization under certain circumstances, was adopted by the North American Jewish Student Network at its annual convention held at Case-Western University.

**JERUSALEM (WNS)** -- As a means of finding out who has been leaking classified Cabinet information to the press, Minister - Without-Portfolio, Gideon Hausner, of the Independent Liberal Party, proposed that all Cabinet members take lie detector tests.

**JERUSALEM (WNS)** -- A call for the dissolution of the present Chief Rabbinate and the Chief Rabbinat Council and for the holding of new elections for both bodies has been issued by Sephardic Chief Rabbi Ovadia Yosef.

**LONDON (WNS)** -- The KGB raided the homes of more than 100 Jewish activists linked to the publications, "Jews in the USSR" and "Tarbut --The Culture Report." The homes of four of those most prominently connected with these publications were raided by the KGB shortly after the departure from the USSR of British Chief Rabbi Immanuel Jakobovits, who had been assured by Soviet officials that efforts would be made to ensure Jewish cultural life in the Soviet Union.

**JERUSALEM (WNS)** -- Foreign Minister Yigal Allon has reportedly proposed that Israel begin "informal" negotiations with Jordan for an interim agreement at which West Bank Arab leaders would be part of the Jordanian delegation.

**MEXICO CITY (WNS)** -- Foreign Minister Emilio Rabasa has unexpectedly resigned in the wake of criticism that he went too far in trying to placate Israel following Mexico's vote for the resolution equating Zionism with racism in the United Nations General Assembly.

**SUIT CHARGES CABINET VIOLATES U.S. JEWS**

**WASH. - (WNS)** -- The American Jewish Congress has filed a suit in Federal District Court here charging four members of President Ford's Cabinet with violating the constitutional rights of American Jews who are excluded from participating in government - sponsored programs in Saudi Arabia because of their religion.

Charging that the Federal government was a "silent partner" in Saudi Arabia's "religious bigotry against Jews," the AJCongress asked for an injunction barring Secretary of

State Henry Kissinger, Treasury Secretary William E. Simon, incoming Secretary of Commerce Elliot Richardson and Interior Secretary Thomas Kleppe from implementing a 1974 U.S. - Saudi Arabian agreement calling for cooperation between the two countries in the fields of economics, technology and industry.

The suit is a class action filed by the AJCongress, four of its officials, and two private persons, Louis Kaplan of the University of Wisconsin and Martin Watkins, of West Chester, Pa., an English teacher, both of whom charged they were denied employment for projects in Saudi Arabia because they are Jewish.
