of abandoning its "covenant" for the dismemberment of Israel or lose the image of "moderation" it has managed to cultivate at international forums. Harkabi was bitterly attacked by Likud which noted that similar remarks were made recently in the Knesset by Prof. Shlomo Abineri of the Hebrew University. Likud described Harkabi's interview as the "second lecture within a week on the necessity to tear from the Jewish people's sovereignty parts of its homeland, an act which would inflict unforeseeable dangers."

Allon meanwhile told the Knesset that if Israel was to ignore the question of the Palestinian identity it would strengthen not weaken the PLO. He said if Israel ignored this problem, friendly countries that agree with Israel that the PLO is not a suitable partner for negotiations would have adopted a more negative attitude. He said that "if the PLO is reaping demonstrative successes in international organizations this is not because our counter-arguments are wrong or the line we have adopted is mistaken; it is the result of a combination of negative factors which, to our regret, characterizes today the entire international arena -- capitulation to Arab terror and oil blackmail; trembling knees and even sometimes naivete, genuine or pretended."

### ISRAEL URGED TO CONTINUE HOLY EXCAVATIONS

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israel was urged to continue its excavations in Jerusalem by the Jerusalem Committee, a group of mostly-non-Jewish public figures and scholars.

The committee which meets annually to advise Mayor Teddy Kollek on the future of the city, adopted a resolution praising the "commitment of the Israeli government and the skill of its archaeologists" which it said has "put the civilized world in their debt."

Dr. Franklin Murphy, chairman of the Los Angeles Times-Mirror publishing and broadcasting chain, said UNESCO should have praised Israel for the excavations instead of condemning it. - The Rev. W.G.M.

Brandful, general secretary of the Christian Council of Ghana, said, "I can go back to my people and defend the position that these excavations are on behalf of scholarship."

A committee resolution noted that the digs bring to light finds of Christian and Moslem importance as well as Jewish.

### ISRAEL SCIENTISTS SEEK

#### OIL FROM ALGAE

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israel may be able to synthesize a high grade of oil from a certain type of algae that thrives in sunlight, according to a team of Hebrew University scientists headed by Prof. Ben Zion Ginzberg.

The team stresses that if the project is undertaken immediately Israel could meet its oil requirements through this process by 1980. According to an announcement from the university, the team has already produced a high grade of oil from the algae that grows ab-

undantly in salt water under strong sunlight. The oil is of such quality that it requires little further processing.
