

KISSINGER DENIES ISRAEL'S REQUESTS ARE INFLATED

WASH. (WNS) -- A report that the \$2.3 billion in military and economic aid the Administration has recommended for Israel will result in a \$500 million budget surplus was vigorously denied by Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger.

Replying to questions at a news conference, Kissinger said he was "not familiar" with an alleged CIA study of the Israeli economy which reportedly said that Israel's requests for U.S. assistance were "greatly inflated." Kissinger said that "even at the level of \$2.3 billion" of American aid "Israel will have to engage in an austerity program in order to make ends meet."

The Israeli Cabinet has just adopted an IL 84.2 billion austerity budget which provides for heavy cuts in government spending in all departments.

The alleged secret CIA report was revealed in a column by syndicated columnists Rowland Evans and Robert Novak. They said that excessive demands were made on the

U.S. by Premier Yitzhak Rabin's government as its price for agreeing to the second interim agreement with Egypt.

Veteran Mapam leader Yaacov Hazan has urged Israel to devise a plan for the future of Jerusalem as a means of combating proposals for the city from other sources.

Hazan suggested his own plan to the Mapam political committee which would leave the city united and governed by a single municipal authority but allow some form of self-government to small government authorities based on demographic population. He said the Old City should be governed by a committee of Jews, Christians, and Moslems with Israel maintaining the responsibility for order.

Hazan also said that Jerusalem Arabs could either maintain citizenship in some state east of Jerusalem or become Israeli citizens. He said if they retain their Arab citizenship they should be given all the rights of Israeli citizens ex-

DEAD SEA LINK TO MEDITERRANEAN

JERUSALEM (WUP) -- The completion of a hydroelectric plant in the Dead Sea is expected to develop an hitherto unknown industry in the Arab desert -- fish breeding. The Commerce and Industry Ministry has sponsored a feasibility study of a plan to dig a tunnel linking the Mediterranean with the Dead Sea to channel water to power the proposed 300 MW power plant, a plan originally proposed by Theodore Herzl 73 years ago.

The proposed plant, the study noted, could generate about 10% of the nation's electricity demand in ten years time. In addition, the Mediterranean water could help replenish the Dead Sea, which is being pumped dry by the potash works, and make possible the formation of artificial lakes to be used for sports.
