ISRAEL BOYCOTTS DEBATE ON MIDEAST U.S. ONLY UN VOTE AGAINST PLO

host the congregation to a Kiddush in the Entratter Social Hall immediately after the Services.

Israel, as expected, stayed away from the United Nations General Assembly debate on the Middle East.

The first motion on the agenda as the session opened on Monday, was to invite the Palestine Liberation Organization to participate, which obviously was the reason for the Israeli boycott. The United States was the only vote against inviting the PLO.

Eleven states voted in favor of the motion, with Britain, France and Italy abstaining.

U.S. Ambassador Daniel P. Moynihan maintained the PLO, not being a state, and therefore not subject to regulation by the U.N., would be an improper participant.

Israel Ambassador Chaim Herzog, who called a press conference prior to the General Assembly meeting, stated firmly that any resolutions passed concerning the Middle East, would have no significance without the participation of one of the major parties. Herzog said, like other resolutions passed by the "lopsided" majority at the U.N., it would be relegated to the waste basket.

WARNING AGAINST U.S. SHIFT TO PLO

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Any shift in American foreign

policy in favor of the Palestine Liberation Organization "may have dire consequences that may recall the volcanic days of the infamous Munich pact," Harold Ostroff, president of the Workmen's Circle told the group's National Executive Committee.

He said that unless the United States "stands fast against appeasement, 1976 can be as fateful for world Jewry and the world as was 1939" when the Munich pact was signed. Ostroff urged world Jewry to close ranks and urged a strong labor-liberal coalition to reassert itself in the U.S. to work with Jewish communities at home and abroad "to avert economic and social backlashes from shifts in foreign policy."
