Hadassah tours are booked exclusively into 5 - and 4 - star hotels, use air - conditioned busses, and trained guides who have worked closely with its Tourism Dept., which was organized in 1948.

Mrs. Usdan said that 1976 has been designed as the "Journey to Zion" -- the year of tours. Many tourists visited Israel for the first time through Hadassah, according to Mrs. Usdan. She said that doctors, nurses, teachers and

other skilled professionals who have been on Hadassah tours, have later returned to Israel as volunteers after having met their counter-parts there. Businessmen have established con-

tacts with Israel's growing economic community.
"Among our own members," she said, "this
