UN Forgets PLO Terrorism

There was a disturbing silence about terrorism during the United Nations Security Council debate on the Middle East. Not only were the Communist - Arab bloc urging that the Palestine Liberation Organization be included in future Middle East negotiations, including the Geneva conference, but so were such countries as France and Sweden.

Yet there was no mention by these countries of the PLO's terrorist activities. It would seem that the minimum requirement for PLO participation in negotiations would be a renunciation of terrorism.

Of course, Israel and the United States are correct in asserting that the PLO cannot be a partner to negotiations because it does not accept the right of Israel to exist and because it rejects Security Council Resolutions 242 and 338 which are the basis for the Mideast peace negotiations.

At the same time, Israel's refusal to participate in the Security Council because of the presence of the PLO has not helped Israel's position. Israel is not there to state its position and thus allows the Arabs to pose as the moderates in the conflict. There is evidence that Israel realized this in the weeks before the began but the Rabin government had painted itself into a corner from which it could not extricate itself without causing severe domestic political repercussions.

Japan, Britain, France and Sweden have all urged Israel to attend the Security Council debate. Some analysts have speculated that not doing so has left Israel even more isolated in UN than before. This, along with the United States refusal to give a blanket promise to veto any resolution that comes out of the debate, really means that Israel has no one at the Council that it can rely on to completely defend its national interests.

UN Becomes Forum For Israel's Enemies

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- The 'mighty' Security Council -- which, according to the Charter, is dutybound to "act in accordance with the purposes and principles of the United Nations" -- has to its everlasting shares its doors and given legitimate status to a gang of murderers whose main proclaimed aims stand in violation of the very Charter principles upon which the world organization was established.

undo Israel.

Declaring that "the Palestinian tragedy" began with the "iniquitous Balfour Declara-tion," Yasir Arafat's henchman, Khaddoumi --in a diatribe which in its attack on Israel, has had no parallel in UN history -- spoke at length on the now well-known program of his murderous organization, heaping criticism upon the world body which he said "did not have any right in 1947 to partition our country."

Exploiting the recognition he had been given by the Council, Khaddoumi in his diabolic statement outdid himself in his fanatical attempts to turn the clock back to the years 1920, 1929 and 1936 during which the Mufti - instigated Arabs rioted against innocent Jewish men, women and children in bloody massacres. These he tried to impress the Council with being "revolutions" by "legitimate partisans" when in reality they were programs by murderous governments. they were pogroms by murderous gangs sneak-ishly and cowardly launched against civilians.

Completely discounting Jewish accomplishments in a land laid barren and waste for generations by the Arabs, he presented a picture of an Arab 'paradise' in the pre-Israeli Palestine, which, he charged, the Jewish "usuerpers" had taken over in "a sinster scheme against our

And judging by the reaction of the Council members, the 'big lie' -- repeated time and again in his speech -- appeared to have struck chord of acceptance. a chord of acceptance. And this acceptance was reenforced by a latter succession of vicious speeches delivered by a host of Arab Ambassadors who had been invited to participate in the debate. With minor variations, they endorsed the PLO position.

Perhaps now, with their petro-dollars and the support of the Soviet Union along with the Third World, the Arabs must have felt, they may succeed in what they failed to accomplish in 1947 and 1948.

But, to their dismay, they are faced with one mighty stumbling - block: the United States whose dynamic spokesman, Daniel Patrick Moynihan, was alone in opposing the seating of the PLO. Moreover, the United Kingdom, France, and Italy abstained. These four will never agree to a one-sided pro-PLO resolution, and Moyni-

War 2, the United States has assumed heavy responsibility for securing world order. Or Angola, he said Congress was short - sighted. Flexibility was necessary in foreign affairs and that flexibility should rest with the President. (No comment.)

Ford made one reference to the Mideast, He said key elements for peace among nations there now exist. (We have to comment on this.) We are certain that President Ford would

like to see affairs commence to settle between Israel and the Arabs and a lasting, just peace in the making.

But so would Israel, and so would the Arabions. The big trick is to bring this about, and Ford is not nearly enough forceful in words or action to help the cause.

President Truman would have stated, in no

uncertain terms, that Israel is here to stay and those who seek to eliminate the Jewish state (as the PLG insists) are creating havoc.

Before selling wheat to Russia, President Kennedy would have made the Soviets agree to stop inciting the Arabs. While the U.S.S.R. keeps feeding billions in arms to Syria and Iran. the U.S. sends American weaponry, not only to Israel, but also to the Arabs.

Annual U.S. arms sales to the Persian Gulf area is \$4.3 billion annually. The Arab countries receiving the war supplies agreed not to transfer the weapons to other countries, but the arms

are reaching the Arab confrontation states.
A House International Relations sub-committee reported that Iran flew Saudi troops to Syria in U.S. - supplied transport planes during the Yom Kippur War. Do you think Truman or Kennedy would have sold Iran \$6.5 billion in

arms, as was done during the past two years?
Saudi Arabia, the money-bags in the Mideast,
who ordered almost \$4 billion in arms from the since 1974, conducted joint aerial training missions with Syria.

It is interesting to note that from 1970 to 1975, U.S. arms actually delivered to the Gulf states amounted to \$7.94 billion, but contract orders since 1974 from Iran, Kuwait and Saudi Arabia are almost eleven billion dollars.

The sub-committee recommended a reduc-tion in the total sales, because the restrictions against transfers to third countries cannot be prevented.

Unless, and until, President Ford puts a definite and all - inclusive ending to supply-ing arms to nations that could get the U.S. in-volved in a world conflict, his administration will be as listless and meaningless as his State of the Union message, so far as foreign affairs is concerned.

It's just too bad.

han has pledged to veto such a draft.

Ambassador Chaim Herzog, who boycotted the debate, appeared at the UN on the fourth day of the deliberations and met with the press corps and thus presented Israel's position for the whole world to know. His opening state-ment is worth recording: Serving as an answer to the Security Council fiasco, it follows: "The deliberations of the Security Council

have only confirmed our initial evaluation, both as to the irrelevance of such discussion at this time and as to the effectiveness in moving the

Middle East towards peace.

"In fact, the whole situation is utterly incongruous and only goes to prove the basic unreality of the present discussion. The Security Council is fiddling while a state in the Middle

East, the Lebanon, burns and a human tragedy evolves before our very eyes.

"Yet in Lebanon a human tragedy of immense proportions is unfolding before our eyes. More people have been killed in the fighting in the Lebanon in the past few months than Israel has lost in all its wars with its neighboring Arab states. "Syria has never accepted the separate

existence of the Lebanon. To this day there is no exchange of Ambassadors between the two
