countries for this very reason.

"Once again we see the Palestinian Arabs being used as a pawn to further the aims of an Arab country.

"It is no coincidence that parallel with the opening of this debate we read of the stepping up of the activities of the Palestinian units in Lebanon in the process of dismembering that state.

"The recurrent attempts to place the Palestinian Arab problem as the central issue in the conflict are only designed to mislead and to ignore the fundamental issue. As we have said time and again, Palestinian Arabs and territorial issues are important, but they are not the essence of the problem. The essence of the problem, I repeat, is the Arab refusal to recognize the right of the Jewish nation to self-determination and national sovereignty."

A background policy statement, released during the Herzog press conference, warns that "those who recognize the PLO, or who, in one way or another, lend it their support and encouragement, as the UN General Assembly has done and as the Security Council is doing now, in effect lend support to the PLO's central aim of replacing the State of Israel with a PLO-run Arab State in which the Jews, at best, be relegated to the status of a tolerated minority.

Israel's position on the Palestinian problem is clear. It is based on the existence of two independent states: Israel, with united Jerusalem as its capital, and a Jordanian-Palestinian Arab State, east of Israel within borders to be determined in negotiations between Israel and Jordan in which the independent identity of the Jordanian and Palestinian Arabs can find expression in peace and good-neighborliness with Israel.

Speaking to about 350 high school and college youths at a dialogue sponsored by the American Zionist Youth Foundation, Mrs. Meir declared:

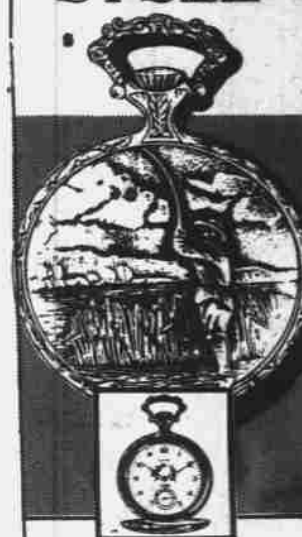
