food "sold overseas had paid for 23 billion of that oil." But he made it clear that America "sits on a supply of coal which is greater in its available energy than all the oil in the Middle East."

In 1976, "the American dollar will remain strong as against other currencies, as will our favorable balance of trade," Leo Cherne promised. "But, we are in the midst of a crisis of belief and a crisis of belief can only be resolved by belief. 'Will' depends on something most doomsayers have overlooked -- crisis, mortal danger, shock, massive, understandable challenge. Go back to the American historical record and what it tells: Vietnam, Korea, Pearl Harbor, Fort Sumter, the Alamo -- each was a surprise, but each set loose a torrent of energies. The same thing was true of the non - military side of 'will.' Get to the moon, unlock the atom's secret, educate all the children.

"Between the Great Adventures, the sense of excitement dies," the noted political and economic analyst of world renown reminds us. "For better or worse, the Americans are that kind of civilization -- 'Don't get involved' until you must; then give it all you have. In that sense, today's loss of resolve could be deceptive, the confusion and loss of direction 'normal' for foreign affairs...."

As a whole, Leo Cherne's masterful and historic address held out much for America versus hostile and rising totalitarian blocs around the world so glaringly reflected in the 'tyranny of the majority' here at the United Nations which has made not only the Jewish state but also this land of the free and brave the target of its main attack.

It is well then for all Americans to reflect deeply on Cherne's admonition:

"Our revolution was made by men of great humanity. There was no dichotomy then between culture and courage, between sentiment and strength. Valuing life deeply was not an antithesis to the willingness to risk it. There are words which still echo down the corridors of time: 'These are times that try men's souls. The summer soldier and the sunshine patriot will, in this crisis, shrink from the service of his country; but he that stands it now, deserves the love and thanks of man and woman. Tyranny, like hell, is not easily conquered. What we obtain too cheap, we esteem too lightly.' With these words, Tom Paine rallied a citizen army...."

With such outstanding Americans like Leo Cherne and Daniel Patrick Moynihan -- and they are not few -- there's hope for the future of the United States, ever - faithful friend of Israel.

**RABBI LEINOW SPEAKER FOR MENS CLUB SABBATH AT BETH SHOLOM**

teaching a technique of communication which helps each couple deepen their commitments towards each other and Judaism.

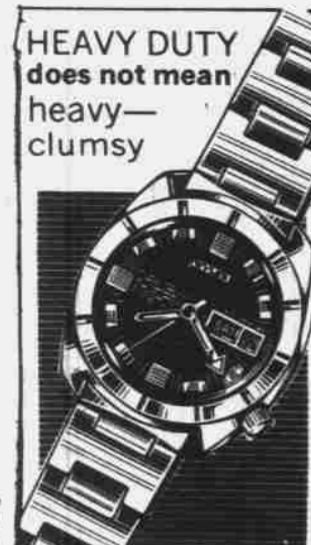
He is married to the former Joanne Kronenberg of Cleveland and Los Angeles, who is a trained social worker. They have two lovely daughters.
