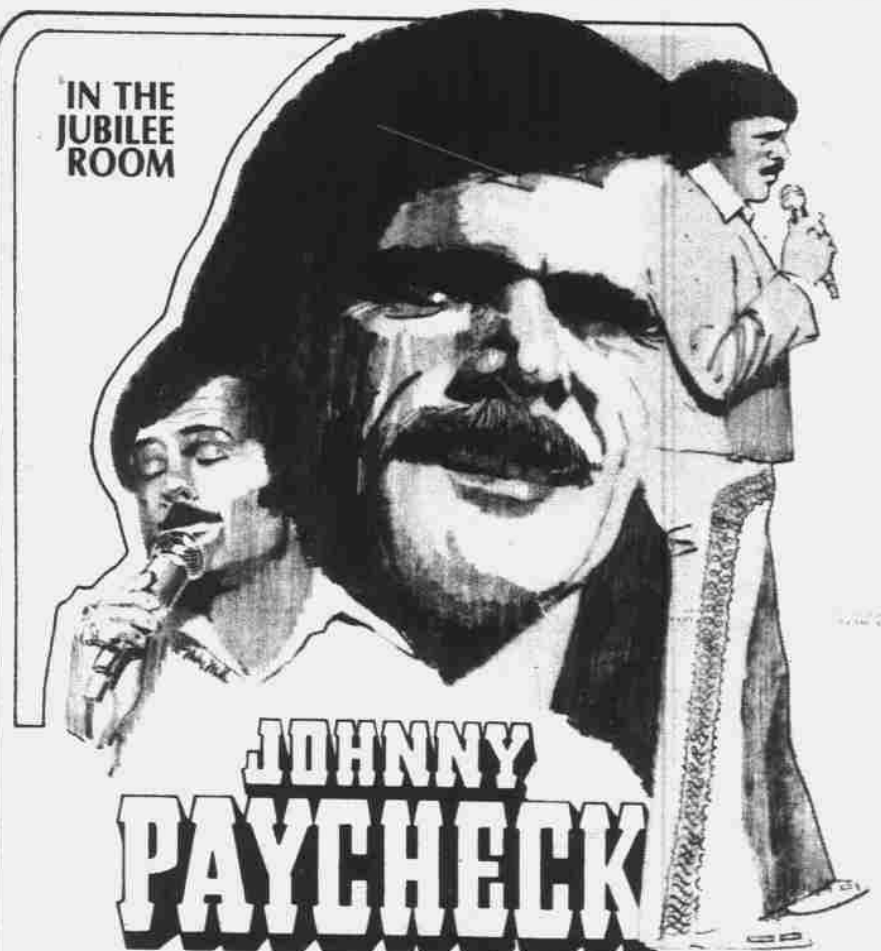
Mac Davis rose to the top of his

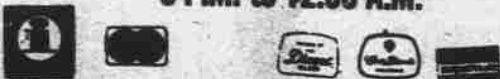
