JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The parties in Premier Yirzhak Rabin's coalition government rallied be-hind him to debate a Likud motion of no-con-

fidence in the government by a 63-34 vote. Haim Landau, a leader of Likud's Herut faction introduced the motion on the grounds that Rabin's remarks in the U.S. that Israel's weapons list was sloppy, inflated, and reflected as house an Israel and housed leaded no honor on Israel, had harmed Israel and

Greenspun Slurs Jew

In addition to the vile language he used, Greenspun violated every concept of honest journalism by adminedly commenting on matters before the court in which he was personally involved. He has so flagrantly abused this ethic in the past, his readers practically accept it as common-place among honest newspapermen. We hasten to state this is not true. Greenspun is the sole publisher in all of America, to our knowledge, who violates the principle and brings dishonor and disrepute to the entire Fourth Estate When Greenspun attempted to justify his abusive, stinking remarks by stating "Informally
