

RABBIS SAY VATICAN INSENSITIVE TO ISRAEL

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The Vatican has been accused of insensitivity toward Israel by two Orthodox rabbis.

Rabbi Fabian Schonfeld, president of the Rabbinical Council of America, accused the Catholic Church of "lacking the moral courage" to recognize Israel and with "yielding to Arab pressure." He said "the insensitivity of the Vatican to the major concern of world Jewry, namely, the State of Israel, constitutes a barrier and an obstacle which prevents a true amity and mutual understanding."

Rabbi Benjamin Blech, president of the Council of Young Israel Rabbis, charged Pope Paul VI

with being "politically misguided" and "morally insensitive" for his condemnation of Israel's air raid against terrorist bases in Lebanon last December while remaining silent about the reason for the raids -- the "vicious killing" of Israeli civilians by Lebanese-based terrorists.

SEN. CHURCH RAPS ARAB BOYCOTT

WASIL (WNS) -- A call for more decisive governmental and congressional action against the Arab boycott threat to Israel was made by Sen. Frank Church (D, Idaho).

He spoke to more than 200 young Jewish leaders from the United States and Canada at the founding national conference of the New Leadership of Israel Bonds. Church demanded that there be full disclosure of those companies which participate in restrictive trade practices against Israel, companies which do business with Israel and firms which are owned or employed by American Jews. He said if his bill, calling for making public the names of companies which discriminate against Israel or American Jews, is passed it will discourage firms from doing business with the Arabs on

Israeli Ambassador Simcha Dinitz told the group that Israel will not pay for votes at the United Nations as the Arabs have done with petrodollars. "Israel does not believe in expedience," he said. "We believe in the strength of our own convictions."

The conference voted to establish a National Cabinet of the New Leadership Division of Israel Bonds with Michael Scharf, of New York, as its national chairman.
