RABIN SAYS FORD ADMINISTRATION HEATS UP ARMS RACE IN MIDEAST

JEFF KAUFMAN BAR MITZVAH

HEBREW U. SCIENTIST DISCOVERS NEW GASOLINE

JERUSALEM (WUP) -- Prof. Ben-Zion Ginzburg, a Hebrew University scientist, has extracted high-grade gasoline quality oil from algae in a test tube. Excited about his discovery, Prof. Ginzburg declared in an interview here that "once the project is put on a commercial scale, it could solve the world's oil problem."

The noted scientist has extracted the oil from a green algae known as *dumaliella*, a micro-organism that thrives in strong sunlight common to the desert and bodies of warm salt water.

Prof. Ginzburg has proposed the construction of solar ponds in the Dead Sea to farm the algae there. Cost of such a project, he noted,

will be far less than the cost of drilling for oil.

ISRAEL WILL HAVE NO-NICOTINE CIGARETTE

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israelis will have a new cigarette in three months that can be either smoked or eaten. The cigarettes will be made of dry lettuce leaves by a process developed over the past five years by an Argentinian Jew, Dr. Gregorino Rubinstein.

The tentative name is "Long Life" because it contains no nicotine and has at least 50 percent less tar than any other cigarette on the market. Dr. Rubinstein said that while many vegetables could have been used, he selected lettuce because it can be dried in the field and in Israel's climate there are three lettuce crops a year. The 10-stage biomechanical process neutralizes the lettuce taste and a negligible quantity of tobacco is added to give the smoke the familiar flavor.

SUPPORT YOUR LAS VEGAS ISRAELITE NOW IN 12TH YEAR.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Premier Yitzhak Rabin has accused the Ford Administration of heating up the arms race in the Middle East by its proposal to end the American arms embargo on Egypt and the recently announced plan for a \$1.2 billion arms deal with Saudi Arabia.

Rabin said that since the U.S. is committed to maintaining the military balance of power in the Mideast it would have to supply greater quantities of arms to Israel and thus would become "a moving force in the Middle East arms race." Speaking to eighth grade pupils he said that "Israel's policy is to try to persuade nations with whom it has ties not to sell weapons to nations hostile to Israel."

He specifically mentioned that Israel will make every effort to block the American sale of six Hercules C-130 transport planes to Egypt. Israeli Ambassador Simcha Dinitz in Washington has lodged a protest over the proposed sale with Undersecretary of State Joseph J. Sisco. Rabin had earlier told the Knesset that he will make every effort to persuade the U.S. not to go through with the sale to Saudi Arabia since the weapons could reach the "confrontation states."

In Washington, Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger told the House International Relations Committee that the sale of the F-130s was in American interest whether Israel approved or not. He said the Ford Administration had agreed to the sale to "symbolize to Egypt that it has some Western connections," adding "but, of course, we cannot be the principal arms suppliers of Egypt." Kissinger stressed that Egypt is no longer receiving arms or spare parts from the Soviet Union. "This has been a very courageous
