Israel Seeking Friends in Latin America

Israel is making an important effort to improve relations with its traditional friends in Latin America. The most important of these efforts was the official visit by Foreign Minister Yigal Allon to Mexico.

Allon and his host, Mexican Foreign Minister Alfonso Garcia Robles, took great pains to stress that Israel and Mexico had cleared up the "misunderstanding" between them caused by Mexico's vote for the anti-Zionist resolution at the United Nations. They both pointed out that the relationship between the two countries was based on friendship and understanding.

Perhaps the most important part of the Allon visit was the series of joint ventures that were agreed upon, or discussed, in chemicals, airplane manufacturing, agriculture, and in other economic and cultural areas.

There were of course differences. Israel is unhappy over Mexico's permission to the Palestine Liberation Organization to set up an office in Mexico City but the two foreign ministers said that even in the areas where there was disagreement there was now understanding of each other's views.

Prior to Allon's visit which also included visits to Guatemala, Costa Rica and Honduras, Aba Gefen, director to the Israel Foreign Ministry's department of culture and scientific exchange, visited eight Latin American countries signing cultural and scientific agreements with them.

The Arabs and the Palestine Liberation Organization have been making inroads in Latin America. It is good to see that Israel is not allowing its traditional friends to be lost by default but is determined to see that it will still have support in that region.

Christians for Jews VS Jews for Jesus

NEW YORK (WUP) -- the Purim season, which recalls the fate that befalls all those who seek Israel's destruction -- and there are many counterparts of Haman on the global scene today -- is a good time to take up an issue involving some of our own brethren devoting their entire lives in a sinister effort to break down Jewry's eternal heritage as embodied in the Torah.

While there are many outstanding Christian theologians who not only champion the State of Israel but, more importantly, urge Jews to remain faithful to their Torah-faith -- among them the noted theologian A. Roy Eckhardt -- we have in our midst a few recalcitrant 'rabbits' with no standing in the rabbinical world who have set up houses of worship whose main aim is to dilute the basic ideals of Judaism. These very few 'rabbits,' graduates of semi-

...naries, appear to be in competition with Moses Rosen's "Jews for Jesus" movement which is capturing hundreds of young uninformed Jewish students on the campuses and in the streets where thousands of tracts are being handed out daily.

The real danger to our Hebraic faith, however, lies with the "Rabble" who, exploiting the title of 'rabbi,' are injecting christological tenets into their services.

One such 'rabbi' here in New York is Dr. Roy A. Rosenberg, a graduate of a Reform Seminary and still listed as a member of the Reform movement.

Not so long ago Dr. Rosenberg shocked the Jewish community including most of our leading Rabbis by his insertion of an ad in the New York dailies announcing the establishment on the lower East side of what he termed "The Temple of Universal Judaism, Congregation Daat Elohim."

The ad contained a "Statement of Principles," the third of which read:

"We hold that the insights of the great religious leaders of the world should become part of our spiritual life. We integrate, for example, the teachings of Jesus the man of Nazareth into the framework of Judaism, for his are genuinely Jewish teachings that stress the need for an inward sincerity instead of an outward show of piety."

Now, while the Nazarene did lay stress on some of the teachings of the Hebrew Prophets, as recorded in the New Testament, his major pronouncements -- if indeed they were really his -- served only to invalidate the Torah and everything held sacred by the Jewish people. This is proved by the fact that the true Sabbath (Saturday, the seventh day) became Sunday; Passover Easter, circumcision -- baptism, etc.

Dr. Rosenberg, apparently, has forgotten the Inquisition, the pogroms, etc., all in the name of the Nazarene, in the name of so-called 'Christianity.'

This writer would recommend that 'Rabbi' Rosenberg and all those who have fallen into his net read a true Christian's appraisal of the great harm that has come to the Jewish people as a result of some of those "teachings" interpolated into the evangelical volume known as the New Testament. We have reference to A. Roy Eckhardt's latest book entitled "Your People, My People: The Meeting of Jews and Christians" (Quadrangle, The New York Times Book Co., New York).

The volume is reviewed in the December 1975 issue of Midstream by Rabbi Roland B. Gittelsohn, spiritual leader of Boston's Temple Israel.

Rabbi Gittelsohn, who terms Eckhardt as one of "the righteous of the nations of the world," cites several passages from the book. One of these is worth recording:

 Canal, built with American dollars in 1914, and maintained by us since.

Russia, in keeping with its policy of never using its own manpower, sends Cuban troops to Angola, and Castro is calling Communist China an agent of the U.S.

Kissinger, who professes to be an American and a Jew, turns out to be neither when his secret arrangements with Russia and the Arab countries are revealed as both anti-American and anti-Israel.

Upon the urging of administration officials, the House International Relations Committee denied an amendment to the Security Assistance Act of 1976, passed by the Senate, which would have barred Saudi Arabia from future U.S. arms deals because they bar entry visas to American Jews.

A Senate - adopted amendment requires the President to terminate all assistance for one year to any country which "aids and abets" terrorism, which will probably be left out of any conversation when the Syrian premier visits Washington next month.

After all the hullabaloo about "Detente" being a one-way arrangement, favoring Russia, Ford says he'll eliminate the word in the future, but a rose by any other name, smells.

Again on U.S. arms to Egypt, which needs tractors, not tanks, what with intense poverty and deteriorating social services bringing that Arab country to the brink of disaster.

Israel, with the most benevolent military occupation of all time, is accused of "war crimes" during the 1967 Six-Day War, with the U.S. the only note against, while supposed allies like Britain, France, Italy, West Germany, Austria, Canada, Costa Rica and Uruguay abstained -- some friends?

dogmatic and existential barrier to any victory over anti-Semitism...The foundation of Christian anti-Semitism and the church's contribution to the Nazi Holocaust were laid 1900 years ago; the line from the New Testament through the centuries of Christian contempt for Jews to the gas ovens and crematoria is unbroken...The one long range moral remedy is explicit Christian renunciation of New Testament falsehoods...Yet the truth remains that the historical structure of Christianity is erected upon a Big Lie: 'The Jews' rejection and murder of Jesus Christ. Repeat a lie enough times and it becomes 'the truth.' The brainwashing has been so unrelenting and pervasive that even the non-believers among us readily accept the tale. Dr. Eckhardt and many of his Christian colleagues, both Catholic and Protestant, have fully recognized the eternal validity of the Mother Faith as the source of truth as against the 'Big Lie' interpolations injected into the Gospels by those who sought to perpetuate hatred of the People of the Book. That a 'Jew', and a 'rabbi' at that, should lend a hand to such infamy, can only serve to foster anti-Semitism such as Dr. Eckhardt has clearly indicated.
