Israel is not opposed to the U.S. improving its relations with Egypt. "Israel has not objected to the development of political, economic and the development of portical, economic and technological ties between the U.S. and Egypt," he said, "but when it comes to the sensitive field of a military supply relationship Israel views it with great concern and sees in it a dangerous course of action."

State Department spokesman Robert Funseth said the Administration was discussing with Congress and the Israeli government the "whole general question, of what it should do in the situation" in which Egyptian President Anwar Sadat has decided "not to be dependent on the Soviet Union for military equipment." He said that Ford had not yet sent Congress the required letter of determination formally advising it of the proposed sale of the C-130s. He said the C-130s were the only "specific" military equipment currently being contemplated for sale to Egypt. However, he noted that the Administration has talked to Congress and the Israelis about the "general categories of kinds of military equipment that might to considered" for

shipment to Egypt.

Meanwhile, Rep. William Broomfield (R. Mich)
said Ford has indicated to him he "would not
back off" from beginning a U.S., military supply
relationship with Egypt. Ford told a group of radio interviewers that the sale of the transport planes would not upset the military balance of power between Israel and Egypt. Meanwhile Sens. Jacob K. Javits (R. NY), Clifford P. Case (R. NJ) and Hubert H, Humphrey (D, Minn) have proposed that Egypt buy directly from the Lockheed Corporation rather than from the Pentagon making it a civilian rather than a military sale.
