Fight Anal Boycott

The efforts by the three major Jewish Defense organizations to combat the Arab boycott against Israel have shown results. The Ameri-can lewish Committee, the American Jewish Congress and the Anti-Defamation League have all sought to expose companies that are parti-cipating in the boycott and to find means of combatting

Perhaps most dramatic was the announce-ment by the American Jewish Congress that 22 major American corporation have given it written assurances that they will not submit to Arab boycott demands. This is an outgrowth of a nationwide program by the AJCongress to have shareholders in major corporations seek declaration from the companies on whether they are complying with the boycott. The ADL's recent announcement that 200 companies and 25 banks are helping the Arabs wage economic war against Israel has brought replies from some of against israel has brought replies from some of the firms that they are not complying with the boycott or that they had been participating but will no longer do so. The Jewish organizations have stressed that they are not against Arab investment in the

United States or American firms doing business with the Arabs. But they are against a policy of boycotting Israel or firms that do business with Israel. They are also against companies discriminating against American firms that are owned by Jews or have Jewish directors or employees in order to comply with the boycott, Rabbi Arthur Herizberg, president of the

AJCongress said the assurances from the 22 companies demonstrated that "it is simply not true that major American companies with worldwide interests cannot stand up to the Arab poycott," American business has the economic power and the technological skills needed by the Arabs which should enable them to break the boycott if more companies should stand up against the boycott.

In addition, the Ford Administration should begin enforcing its policy that American com-panies not comply with the boycott. This should be coupled with the adoption by the Congress of the bills aimed at eliminating the use of the Arab boycott in the United States.

This applies especially to the West Bank, the Gaza Strip and the Golan.

Peace, any peace, with Israel whom they have constantly termed a 'cancer' in their midst, is anathema to them. Hence their refusal to enter direct negotiations under any circumintostances.

That all the Arab states are indeed set on the demise of Israel has been borne out here at the UN by the very fact that all of them --yes, including Egypt and Jordan -- have given Yasir Arafat and his PLO spokesmen a starring role in all Middle East deliberations and, apparently, acquiesced to their public clamor for the undoing of the Third Hebrew Commonwealth.

The tragedy here lies in the shameful fact that the Arabs have succeeded in mustering æ majority in the General Assembly in support of the murderous PLO terrorists who might also have gained full Security Council backing if not for the United States veto. Anticipating a possi-ble future veto versus the pro-PLO recom-mendations which the Committee of 20 is to place before the Security Council by June 1, the Syrian Ambassador suggested in his speech last week that the recommendations be brought to the full Assembly for adjudication. That Israel is fully aware of the ultimate

Arab intentions as linked to their espousal of the PLO came to light in an Israeli Mission statement released here at the UN this week. It referred to several PLO declarations broadcast over an Arafatian radio station in Beirut during the past month calling for the destruction of Israel. Among these was a statement by Yasir Arafat's deputy Salah Khalaf who declared, among other things, the following:

There is something the world must know. Let us all die, let us all be killed, let us all be assassinated but we will not recognize Israel.

This is something we cannot bargain about..." Referring to the PLO Covenant, Khalaf stated in another broadcast: "When we went to the UN, there were those who were opposed (to our program). But for our part, we said that we would work in all forums in order to route the Zionist enemy out of everywhere. The important thing is that we should stick to our princi-ples...The Palestinian resistance will set up a national authority on all the territory which is liberated, in order to continue on the way to the liberation of all the land of Palestine...We shall not recognize the Zionist entity on any piece of land."

Here we have the reason why it is impossible for Israel to yield to any UN demand for the turning over of even an inch of territory within historic Erotz Yisrael to the PLO and it is to be hoped that the United States will understand

why, "We must never allow an Arafatian state to arise in our midst," Memachem Begin declared at a reception tendered him by the United Zionists at a reception tendered him by the United Zionists Revisionists of America at the Fifth Avenue Synagogue in New York last week. "Such a state," he said, "would be turned into a Soviet-controlled region" which could lead to "the Angolazation of the entire Middle East,"

Recalling the Nazi Holocaust and the Six Million, the former Irgun here warned that "if an enemy says he will destroy you, he means it." He scored the idea of a settlement with the Arab states on the mere acceptance of so-
