based on a false charge about a decision in an Israeli lower court that was never made, if it were not so tragic, pointing as it does to a calculated attempt by means of falsehoods to incite Moslem feeling throughout the world and to invoke racial, religious and human hatred of the basest kind."

But Scranton, in an attempt to curry Arab favor -- at least, so it appeared to this writer -- paid keen attention to the vicious anti-Israeli Arab statements, the most rabid of all was that of Saudi Arabia's Jamil Baroodi, without a word of dissent. Before his written speech, Scranton indulged "in some personal comments from notes," and one of these referred to "the gentleman from Saudi Arabia, with his inimitable wit and remarkable eloquence and, most important of all and truly and seriously, his very extraordinary knowledge of history."

Scandalous! Here we have a high U.S. tribute to a man who not only continuously distorts history by terming the modern Jew Khazars but who has branded the Zionists racists and who, on several occasions, has praised Hitler.

As the baseball season approaches we look for hard - hitters.

A literary wallop is Leo Mindlin, who is the associate editor of the Anglo - Jewish weekly published in Miami and read all over, the Jewish Floridian.

Mindlin enjoys being Jewish and he revels in writing about matters which enhance our faith.

But he despises the shoddy and he strikes out against those who hurt our cause.

A recent target of his was the American Friends of the Hebrew University. Now, Mr. Mindlin likes the Hebrew University and he supports its Friends.

But he didn't care for their choice of a speaker at a recent confat: Saul Bellow.

Mindlin concedes that Bellow is a good stylist, but a Jewish Jew he is not. Indeed, in his talk he made it clear that he doesn't work at his Jewishness, that he himself doesn't care for most Jewish writers, and that he is "more American than Zionist."

Mindlin agrees with Bellow; the writer isn't much of a Jew, even though many Jews, including Rabbis, have heaped praise on Bellow's head, calling his material Jewish.

Mindlin writes powerfully. He called the Bellow talk a "barrel of bull." He castigates any Jewish organization which glorifies an unworthy "name person" in the hope of getting a captive audience.

What did the best - selling writer do for his patrons of the American Friends of the Hebrew University? He bellowed.

To paraphrase Julius Caesar, when I read Mindlin I came, I saw and I concurred.

Mindlin didn't mentioned another bit of Bel-lowitz that ikkels me: he's a smutler.
