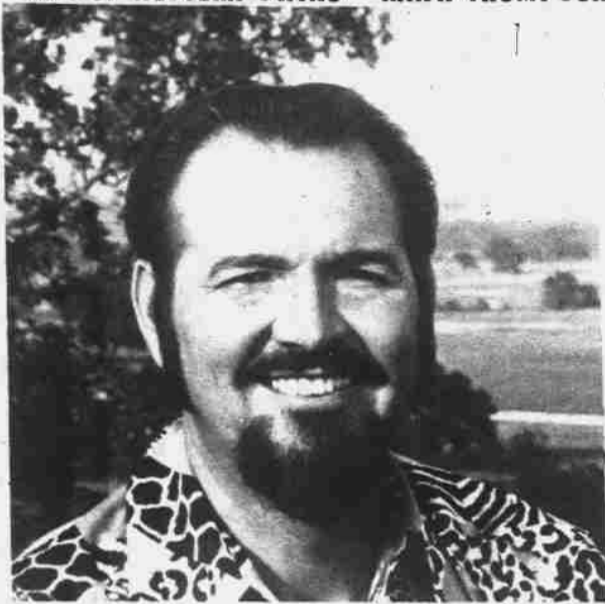

LANDMARK SWINGS WITH "KING OF WESTERN SWING" HANK THOMPSON



HANK

The "King Of Swing" Hank Thompson, who over the last 29 years has sold nearly 35 million records and who has had some 40 songs hit the Billboard country charts, headlines the Landmark's Jubilee Showroom now through April 18. With the living legend are his band. The Brazos Valley Boys, Peter Anthony, Sue Thompson, and Curley Lewis.

From the time Thompson was known as "Hank the Hired Hand" over WACO Radio in Waco, Texas, back in '42, the man has remained musically active, singing and picking his way through the Service; through Princeton University, Southern Methodist and the University of Texas; to his first major label Capitol for whom he recorded his first nationwide hit which sold over a million copies, "Humpty Dumpty Heart," and finally ending up on his present label, Dot, with whom he has recorded since 1952, the same year he signed with the Jim Halsey Agency out

of Tulsa. The man and his band have over the years consistently turned out hit records which include "Smoky The Bar," "On Tap, In The Can Or In The Bottle," "Honky Tonk Girl," "A Six Pack to Go," "Kindly Keep It Country" and his latest chart-ringer "Asphalt Cowboy." In addition to recording, he averages over 240 concerts and personal appearances each year. Whether it be a melancholy, heart wail-type torch song or a

joyous, who-gives-a-darn drinking tune, Hank Thompson is "in" and always has been. The tall, lanky

Hank is a country music giant whose reputation is getting taller by the day. Comic and musician, Peter Anthony the city boy who went country in the Jubilee Room last February, returns bringing with him his quick-witted, off the cuff quips, fresh topical material and fine trumpet ex-

pertise. Sue Thompson, Hickory recording artist and nitery entertainer has gold and silver records to her credit for such hits as "Norman," "Sad Movies," "Paper Tiger" and "James," and is currently hosting an internationally syndicated radio show "Palomino Country"

from the famous country-western headquarters for entertainers on the West coast, the Palomino Club of North Hollywood. Curley Lewis, fiddler with the Brazos Valley Boys is spotlighted as a strong part of this fourteenth edition of "Country Music U.S.A."
