The coalition was formed in response to the recent Clark County Grand Jury recommendation for the construction of a new jail facility in Clark County. It will represent the unnecessary expenditure of millions of tax dollars, they claim.

U.S. Sen. Frank Church of Idaho will give the commencement address at the 13th - annual UNLV graduation ceremonies May 23 for more than 1,000 students who are expected to receive degrees during the exercises in Las Vegas Stadium.
