demanding that the Jews give up the City and return it to the desecrators. The General Assembly acquiesced in this demand.

And today, after the Israelis have proved to the world the success in their unification of the former divided City, we find the United States joining forces with Israel's enemies. It is good to know, however, that the Ford-Kissinger Administration is not reflective of the general American public and November is not too far off.

This world organization, dominated by the 'tyranny of the majority' has given way to the 'Big Lie' and even some Western states have succumbed to it. No matter what Israel would say in exposing the lie, delegates, set in their views, found it convenient to turn a deaf ear. Throughout the sessions here, the voices of the Jewish State had time and again, let the world know that "Jerusalem had never ceased to be part of the Jewish saga" and that "it was no more Arab by virtue of the Arab conquest than it was Turkish when the Turks occupied it or of the British when the British ruled it."

Without surcease the voices continued to resound with no one taking heed: "Jewish history is permeated with the memories of Jerusalem's defense, the desperate attempts to preserve its Jewishness, the destruction of the Temple, the fast and the mourning that the Jewish people have observed ever since the ninth of Ab. One cannot separate Jerusalem from Jewish history, martyrdom and redemption," the voices continued, "Jerusalem is venerated by three great religions and all three share in the City's glory. The people are the City, and the Jews have never left Jerusalem. But after the most sanguinary massacres they came back to it -- the heart of Judaism -- again and again, to heal the City's wounds and rebuild its ruins, and Jerusalem repaid the love and loyalty of its people. It remained ever faithful to it."

One of these voices was that of the dynamic Yosef Tekoah. In referring to the Jewishness of the Holy City during one of the sessions here, he made it plain that "it had served as the Capital of one nation, and one nation alone -- the Capital of the Jewish people. Why," he asked, "should those who have treasured Jerusalem for 3,000 years as their chiefest joy be shorn of the fullness thereof? Why should Jerusalem's Jewish and Arab inhabitants be despoiled of their heritage in the City's unity? Does a conquest in defiance of the UN, a nineteen-year occupation unrecognized by the nations of the world, including the Arabs themselves, give Jordan -- and now the PLO -- the right to oppose Jerusalem's revival, in integrity and radiance?"

"Jerusalem has existed for thousands of years," he declared, "and it was only during the brief nightmare of Jordanian occupation that part of it was carved out and wrested from the
