

CANDIDATES PROMISE STRONG SUPPORT FOR ISRAEL

NEW YORK, N.Y. -- Presidential candidates have assured Jewish leaders that strong support for Israel would represent an essential policy plank of their administrations.

They further told the representatives of 32 major national Jewish organizations that they would utilize every avenue of personal diplomacy to assist Jews in the Soviet Union.

The meetings were sponsored by the Union of American Hebrew Congregations and the Central Conference of American Rabbis.

The following are the direct quotes from the candidates:

Senator Lloyd Bentsen has consistently voted for military and economic aid to Israel since he has been in the Senate. "I'm greatly concerned about the Arab and the Soviet military build-up in the Middle East...and I don't believe it would be in this country's best interests to allow the military balance in that area to shift against Israel...But there's another threat...a threat that we in the country are...not aware of. And that's the threat of Israel's economic difficulties...The United States can and must help. As for Soviet Jewry -- "All I know is that you... (must) be tougher in negotiations, and put on as many economic pressures as (possible).

Governor Jimmy Carter believes that peace in the Middle East is of vital importance for the United States and that "a basic cornerstone of our foreign policy is the preservation of a viable Israeli nation." Carter further said, "I think ultimately a final solution may very well entail a withdrawal of Israel basically to the 1967 boundaries. If I was the premier of Israel, I would not yield control of the Golan Heights to the Syrians; I would not yield control of the Jewish and Christian holy places. I think that everything our government does and did -- in dealing with the Soviets -- ought to be designed to let them know that we find that their restriction of their Jewish citizens to be unconscionable and an insult to our concepts of human decency.

Fred Harris consistently voted in favor of military and economic aid to Israel. "I've been a very strong advocate of the rights of Soviet Jewry, and the right of people to emi-

grate, from the Soviet Union or anywhere else, wherever they want to go."

Senator Henry Jackson has been a leading proponent of aid to and support for Israel. He voted for or co-sponsored almost every bill and resolution on behalf of Israel. He stated, "The PLO started with genocide against the Jews." Senator Jackson was, of course, the sponsor of an amendment to the trade bill last year which would have withheld Favored Nation Status from the USSR until they had eased their emigration restrictions. "Now, we should stay firm, because three weeks later (after the passage of the amendment) Ford comes before the Congress and says: 'Let's repeal it.'"

Milton Shapp stated "In the face of the 'Zionist resolution,' America must support Israel more strongly than ever...If Israel suffers, we and the rest of the world suffer and human rights everywhere suffer...Support of Israel is clearly in America's self interest."

Sargent Shriver has expressed a strong commitment to Israel. Though stating that the "plight of the Palestinian people must be justly resolved as an essential part of any overall settlement," he emphasized that the "PLO's demand for a 'secular democratic state' is simply a code word for the destruction of Israel."

Morris Udall has consistently voted for major military and economic aid bills for Israel. "I'm not going to make a speech on the Middle East. My position on that is simple and it's firm and it's longstanding. Israel is the home of our hearts, and to abandon it would be abandon our true selves. The United States cannot abandon Israel and won't -- not if I'm the President of the United States."

George Wallace said "Of course, Israel's our friend and I've advocated years ago that we must keep an arms balance... (The Palestine refugee) problem must be solved...I don't believe that we ever should, unless Israel wants to do it, let the PLO be the spokesman for the Palestinians...I hope for moderation. We should not close the door to the Sadats and others, but they must understand that Israel has a right to exist."
