PHILADELPHIA: Dr. Solomon Grayzel, noted Jewish scholar and author, was honored on his 80th birthday at a luncheon held in Philadelphia by The Jewish Publication Society of America.

NEW YORK -- Mifgash Jerusalem, an 18-day Salute to Aliyah through the arts, will be held in Jerusalem from August 7 through August 24.

ZOA HOUSE, NEW YORK -- Each of the 142 delegations to the United Nations and the U.N. Press Corps will receive free copies of the new Zionist Organization of America publication, "History of a National Liberation Movement...a Brief History of Zionism."

ZOA HOUSE, NEW YORK -- A free Public Seminar on the "Changing American Family and Its Impact on Jewish Survival" is to be held at ZOA House, 4 East 34th Street, New York, Thursday, May 6th, at 1:00 P.M. under the sponsorship of the Zionist Organization of America and the ZOA New York Women's Committee.

NEW YORK, N.Y. -- Special courses in Jewish history, Jewish identity through prayer and worship, and Bible are being conducted during the summer months from June 28 - July 23 by the School of Education of Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion, 40 West 68th Street, New York 10023.

NEW YORK -- Because it is difficult to provide young students with an understanding of the historical and present-day significance of the Holocaust, the Board of Jewish Education of Greater New York, 426 W. 58th Street, N.Y.C., 10019, has prepared special materials to assist schools and centers with their observance of the Holocaust Memorial, Yom HaShoah, on April 27.

NEW YORK -- Mrs. Charles Schwartz, New York communal leader who has devoted more than 20 years to promoting an interest in Jewish books, has been elected the first woman president of the Jewish Book Council of JWB.

PHILADELPHIA -- Former U.S. Supreme Court Justice Arthur J. Goldberg and Chief of the Israel Delegation to the United Nations Chaim Herzog will join an impressive list of notables in the American Jewish community's Hall of Fame when they are inducted as Fellows in The Jewish Academy of Arts and Sciences on May 2nd, marking the 50th anniversary of the founding of the Jewish Academy of Arts and Sciences and the nation's Bicentennial.

NEW YORK -- Rabbi Israel M. Goldman, spiritual leader of Chizuk Amuno Congregation in Baltimore, has been named the first recipient of the Rabbi Max Arzt Distinguished Rabbinic Service Award, it was announced by Dr. Gerson D. Cohen, Chancellor of The Jewish Theological Seminary of America, who will present the award at a Testimonial Service, to be held on Sunday evening, June 6.

WASHINGTON -- Rabbi Arthur Hertzberg of Englewood, N.J. was elected to a third two-year term as president of the American Jewish Congress.

NEW YORK -- In an extraordinary closed circuit radio broadcast to 150 communities, UJA General Chairman, Frank R. Lautenberg announced a national campaign closing date of June 6 - coinciding with the anniversary of the Six-Day War.

WASHINGTON -- The American Jewish Congress has called on the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the New York City Police Department to give "highest priority to tracking down all those in the so-called 'Jewish Armed Resistance,'" responsible for shooting into the Soviet Mission to the United Nations in New York.

TEL AVIV (MDA) -- In the keynote address to the 300 Magen David Adom delegates delivered by the Hon. Victor Shem Tov, Israel's Minister of Health at the 10th National Convention of Magen David Adom, he lauded MDA for the overwhelming humanitarian contribution provided by its 7,000 volunteers to the people of Israel on an around-the-clock basis.
