Whatever you've heard about the loriously uninhibited and original "The Divine Miss M" is probably true. Vegas audiences just might not be ready for anyone as devastating as Bette but see her you MUST to see se of show business' mos t talked about, praised, blasted, shocking and electrifying personalities......CONNIE STEVENS looking sooooo sexy these days is at the Las Vegas Hilton in the best show of her Las Vegas career. The blonde and beautiful Miss Stevens — with her special guest stars IKE & TINE TURNER — has got herself all together Connie's powerhouse vocalizing will surprise her television and movie fans.....Luscious LOLA (there's only one FALANA) is making her headliner bow at the MGM Grand with hilarious costar (and fellow Philadelphian) DAVID BRENNER. It didn't take Faberge to tell Falana fans that the lady is a tigress personified. Sexy, saucy, and scintillating, Lola's first "big production show" proves what all the shouting is about. You'll see PLENTY of Lola (Ray Agayhan's costumes are a knockout) but what you might see is ENOUGH of Lola (all by herself and doing the kind of singing and dancing that made her a showstopper every time she appeared here with Sammy Davis Jr).
