Passover Message 1976

On Passover we celebrate the birthday

of the Jewish people as a nation.

The push from Egypt and the pull of the Promised Land, were the twin forces that welded the "mixed-multitude" into a nation and launched the millenia-long adventure. Those same forces have operated throughout our history to bring Jews back to the Land of Israel, and are operative today as the motivating forces behind the turmoil among Jews in the Soviet Union, fighting for the right to Aliyah.

The Second Brussels Conference, this past

February, dramatized the urgency of Jewish demands to leave the Soviet Union and of the unity of world Jewry in support of those demands. What we are all fighting for is nothing less than a modern counterpart to the Passover an exodus which would permit the second - largest concentration of Jews anywhere in the world to rejoin their people and resume their place as part of the Jewish nation.

Like the ancient Egyptians, who first per-mitted the Israelites to leave and following a change of heart pursued them, in a vain attempt to bring them back, the Soviets have once again closed the doors. But the exodus cannot be stopped once started, and Russia's modern Israelites will also make their way to the Promised Land.

In Syria, however, the modern Pharoah is still saying "no" to all Jewish pleas for permission to leave. The oppression is total and unsion to leave. The oppression is total and un-relieved. We Jews in the free world will not rest until that oppression ends and the Jews of Syria. too, are delivered.

Passover is more than the celebration of one liberation millenia ago. As the Haggadah has it, every one of us, in every generation, must consider himself as having been among those who were freed from Egyptian bondage: freedom is never fully achieved for all time but must be never fully achieved. never fully achieved, for all time, but must be struggled for in every generation.

Our Passover celebration this year, the American Bicentennial Year, has an added dimension; recollection of the successful American quest for freedom, and of America's traditional devotion to the cause of freedom throughout the world.

As we observe the Seder ritual and drink to the ancient liberation, we rededicate ourselves anew to increased financial aid to Israel, through the United Jewish Appeal and the Israel Bond Campaign; we reaffirm our commitment to sup-port Aliyah -- the highest form of personal port Aliyah -- the highest form of personal participation in Israel's struggle to remain free.
