20 YEAR ARMS EMBARGO TO EGYPT ENDS AS CONGRESS OK'S 6 PLANES

WILL THERE BE MORE?

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Egypt will get the six C-130 military transport planes promised it by the Ford Administration now that opposition to the sale has evaporated in Congress.

On the eve of the 20-day deadline for opposing the sale, which ends the 20-year American embargo on military arms for Egypt, the House International relations Committee said it would not oppose it. Congress is empowered to veto any governmental military sale to a foreign country in excess of \$25 million by acting within 20 days of receiving Presidential notification of it.

The House committee acted after Sen. Clifford Case (R. NJ), the last major holdout against the sale of the C-130s, expressed satisfaction with the Administration's assurances in writing that the sale is the only one to Egypt this year and that training of Egyptians will be limited to 20 officers. Previously, Sens. Jacob K. Javits (R. NY) and Hubert H. Humphrey (D. Minn) agreed to go along with the Administration after the Administration specifically said that no other sales would be made this year.

But Case also wanted assurances on the training program because he said there was a "loop-hole" which might be used to allow the training of Egyptians in strategy, tactics and "even more important, in weapons system which Congress has not approved for sale to Egypt."

Jews, Pay Attention

(We were going to explain the dilemma being faced by Israel in the upsurge of Israeli Arabs in the Galilee area, but decided to hold it off a week while we bring you up to date on the Administration's favoring of Egypt over Israel.)

It appears that Congress is leaning to the overboard efforts of Secretary of State Henry Kissinger and President Ford to get those six C-130 transport planes for Egypt.

It has also been revealed that what we told you recently of future deliveries of arms to Egypt was part of a planned agenda, starting with non-lethal items and gradually going to anti-aircraft missiles and sophisticated weapons. These were definitely stated intentions by Kissinger and Ford. But a justifiable uproar by Congress caused Kissinger to reluctantly pledge to the Senate Foreign Relations Subcommittee on Foreign Assistance that U.S. will not supply Egypt with additional military equipment THIS YEAR.

The Administration, of course, is backing up. Apparently, if it can't get all it is scheming for Sadat, it will use any means possible to get as much as it can. The compromise maneuver worked and the six planes will be turned over.

Senators, like Humphrey, Jackson and even Javits will not oppose the sale. Sen. Case forced Kissinger to admit that ONLY 20 Egyptian officers will visit American military schools.

Sen. Symington balked at Egyptian military personnel learning U.S. defense plans while here. Kissinger said he had assurances of Sadat's good intentions. Symington came back with "What if Sadat is overthrown?"

We keep asking ourselves, why are Kissinger and Ford so anxious to arm Egypt, why, why? Do they know something of which the rest of the world is not aware? Could any military strengthening of Egypt be conceivably used against one else but Israel?

Here we have the incongruous position of the U.S. arming both sides to a conflict. Who ever heard of that kind of strategy before? Especially when one party is a tried, trusted and true friend ("We will never abandon Israel," Kissinger) and the other is deeply, firmly entrenched in every way with Israel's enemies.

It's not that it doesn't make sense. It is downright stupid. Unless, of course, there are ulterior motives. Could Ford be anti-Semitic? Maybe Kissinger? (We know some Jews who are the worst.) Did the U.S. oil interests get to our President? Has Saudi Arabian money got

ADVISORS TO DEM. HOPEFULS CALL FOR ISRAELI WITHDRAWAL, RAP KISSINGER

WASH. (WNS) -- The foreign policy advisors to the three leading Democratic Presidential candidates have called for an over-all solution to the Arab-Israeli conflict in which Israel would give up virtually all of the occupied territory in return for big power guarantees

of its security. The experts, all of whom served in the Johnson Administration, also criticized Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger's step-by-step diplomacy.

They are George Ball, former Undersecretary of State who is one of the advisors to Sen. Henry M. Jackson of Washington; Prof. Zbigniew Brzezinski, of Columbia University, who is advising former Georgia Gov. Jimmy Carter, and former Assistant Defense Secretary Paul C. Warnke, an advisor to both Carter and Rep. Morris Udall of Arizona. Warnke is also advising Sen. Hubert H. Humphrey of Minnesota.

Ball said that the Israeli-Egyptian disengagement agreement worked out by Kissinger has created a situation "more dangerous than it was" because the Sinai accords have isolated Egypt from the rest of the Arab world.
