HAIFA (WNS) -- There is no longer a single case of an aguna as a result of the Yom Kippur War, Col. Gad Navon, the army's Deputy Chief Chaplain has announced.

Aguna is the halachic term for a woman whose husband is missing but it is not known with absolute certainty that he is dead. Navon said that months of exhaustive painstaking work by a special Beit Din (religious court) has resulted in relieving almost 1000 women from the status of aguna, thereby permitting them to remarry if they wish.

B'NAI B'RITH INSTITUTE HOME FOR AGED

NEW YORK (WUP) -- Gab Cohen, the dynamic editor-publisher of The Jewish Post (Indianapolis and New York) recently reminded his readers of a unique educational center situated on a mountain-top in North Carolina named Wildacres.

The uniqueness of the center lies in the fact that it has been the home of the annual B'nai B'rith Institutes for over two decades as well as the site of retreats for a number of humanitarian groups, both

Jewish and non-Jewish. This writer, thanks to its founder and benefactor, the now 80-year-old I.D. Blumenthal of Charlotte, had the pleasure some years back of being a participant in an Institute panel.

We share fully Gab Cohen's love for Wildacres. In his Editor's Chair, he wrote, in part:

"It's a mountain-top 1400-acre estate which was purchased for a song by Dick Blumenthal after World War II and ever since then operated as a retreat for

Jewish and non-Jewish groups concerned with human welfare...

"Wildacres is only one of the civic contributions of Dick Blumenthal for he is the father of both the Circuit Riding Rabbi program, the only one in the United States, and also of the Jewish Home for the aged near Winston-Salem which is a model for the entire nation.
