

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Stockholders of the Bankers Trust Co. and the Chase Manhattan Bank rejected identical resolutions sponsored by the American Jewish Congress which would require corporate disclosure of participation in the Arab boycott against firms doing business with Israel or in Arab discrimination against Jews.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Members of the family of the late Gen. David (Dado) Elazar have released a document written by him two years ago challenging the findings of the Granat Committee which held him responsible as Chief of Staff for Israel's lack of military preparation when the Yom Kippur War broke out.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The American Jewish Congress has been accused by Dr. Lowell A. Dunlap, assistant executive director of the Catholic League for Religious and Civil Rights of using Hitlerite ideology because of the AJCongress' support of legalized abortion.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- A special ministerial committee has made a mini-devaluation of the Israel Pound for the eighth time since last summer.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Despite a record high temperature of 96 degrees some 2000 young Jews filled the Central Park mall in the first Annual New York City Jewish Youth Fair.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Thirty Catholic and Protestant clergymen, nuns and laymen held an Easter sunrise service opposite the Soviet Embassy on behalf of Soviet Jews.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- George Meany, president of the AFL-CIO has announced that former Israeli Premier Golda Meir will receive the labor movement's highest award for public service.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Sand storms and wind storms accompanied by an unusual heat wave swept throughout the country on the eve and during the first day of Passover.

LOS ANGELES -- "History, Destiny and You," will be the theme of a weekend retreat May 21-23 at the Adams Hotel, Phoenix, Ariz., to be conducted by the Young Leadership Cabinet of the United Jewish Appeal and the Leadership Development Committee of the Council of Jewish Federations and Welfare Funds.

CHICAGO -- The President of Spertus College of Judaica was notified officially by the North Central Association Commission on Institutions of Higher Education that Spertus College has been reaccredited by the NCA without condition for a ten-year period. Additionally, the College was informed that it was accredited at the Master's degree level as well and placed on a decennial review cycle.

NEW YORK -- "It would be a social tragedy of the first magnitude if the debate which is currently developing over a proposed constitutional amendment concerning abortion is permitted to deteriorate into an interreligious conflict," the National Program Director of the National Conference of Christians and Jews has declared.

NEW YORK -- Israel is expanding educational programs for its disadvantaged population under the "Priorities Program" in spite of severe cuts in the general education budget and the country's economic problems, according to a report by Esther R. Landa, National President of the National Council of Jewish Women.

NEW YORK -- The Israel Ministry of Absorption in cooperation with the Ministry of Labor has recently established retraining programs for people intending to settle in Israel. It was announced by Israel Aliyah Center's Employment Specialist, Yitzhak Friedman.

NEW YORK -- Funeral services were held for Dr. Samuel Belkin, President of Yeshiva University for 32 years who was appointed Chancellor of the institution in the fall of 1975. He died April 18, at Albert Einstein College Hospital in the Bronx at the age of 64.

ARCHBISHOP EXPLAINS SEDER

LOS ANGELES -- In a Passover event, more than 1000 Catholic high school students were invited to the Wilshire Boulevard Temple in Los Angeles by Rabbi Edgar F. Magnin to participate in a demonstration of the Seder. The program was introduced by Los Angeles Cardinal Timothy Manning, who explained the significance of the Seder in the Gospel accounts of the Last Supper. The event marked a new high in the cooperation and understanding between Judaism and Christianity. "It is a major breakthrough between the two religions," Manning declared.

Magnin stated: "Passover and Easter are both symbols of hope -- hope for a better world and for a more religious world.... without which we will never be civilized." During the Seder ceremonies Magnin and Manning embraced.
