ious right-wing factions, claim that the West Bank belongs to Israel by divine right and demand

free Jewish settlement in Samaria and Judaea,
Althouth the marchers did not try to establish
any illegal settlements, as had been feared,
some said the trek was the first step toward
legal settlement. Premier Yitzhak Rabin later
met with representatives of 17 Jordan valley
settlements and assured them that they were settlements and assured them that they were there to stay and could count on the government to strengthen and extend Israeli settlements in that area of the West Bank adjacent to the Jordan River. When settlers asked if they should plant olive trees which take 7 - 8 years to bear fruit, Rabin replied, keep planting.

Meanwhile the polarization in Israel over the Gush Emunim march was echoed in New York where Jewish youths demonstrated near the United Nations for and against the marchers. About 200 youngsters, mostly yeshiva students, gathered in Dag Hammarskjold Plaza opposite the UN, to support the marchers. Four blocks away, about 75 members of the recently-formed Socialist Zionist Union assembled at the Isaiah Wall to condemn Gush Emunim as an obstacle to peace in the Mideast.

The march was also condemned by four pro-The march was also condemned by four prominent American Jews -- Rabbi Joachim Prinz, David Tulin, Rabbi Max Ticktin and Rabbi Balfour Brickner -- on behalf of Breira, a national Jewish educational organization. They urged "Jews who support a militarily and morally strong Israel" to reject the notion "that territories are more important than peace" and called on Israel to "prohibit Jewish settlement in the occupied territories." in the occupied territories.'




