

JUDGE GUY, OUTSTANDING PUBLIC SERVANT, TO BE HONORED MAY 14



A testimonial dinner honoring District Judge Addelliar D. Guy has been scheduled for mid-May to pay tribute to the jurist's "distinguished service to all people of Southern Nevada," dinner chairman Robert Archie announced. Prior to his appointment to the bench by Gov. Mike O'Callaghan in 1975, Judge Guy served in the Clark County District Attorney's office in posts ranging from research assistant to Chief Deputy District Attorney.

He has served as Juvenile District Court Judge since January of this year, and, according to Archie, "has earned the respect and admiration of all his peers in whatever post he has held."

The testimonial dinner will be held May 14 at Circus Circus, Archie said, and will be designed "as a fitting tribute to an outstanding human being."

Honorary Chairman Grant Sawyer, former Governor of Nevada, said "Judge Guy exemplified the qualities of knowledge

and compassion his post as Juvenile Judge demand and I am honored to play some part in this tribute event."

According to both Sawyer and Archie, nearly 75 prominent Southern Nevadans have already volunteered their services "in a multitude of capacities" for the event.

Long active in Judge Guy has served on the Southern Nevada Human Relations Committee, Las Vegas Housing Authority, NAACP of Las Vegas, Fitzsimmons House, the North Las Vegas Rotary, the advisory board to the A.D. Guy Boys Club, the executive Board of the March of Dimes and

the Clark County Democratic Central Committee.

The 52-year old native of Chicago was admitted to the Illinois Bar in 1957 following his graduation from Loyola University.

He had a distinguished military career, serving in both the U.S. Coast Guard and the Army and currently holds the position of Lt. Col. Judge Advocate Corps in the Nevada National Guard.
