## GEORGE LINDSEY HEADLINES LANDMARK'S JUBILEE SHOWROOM "COUNTRY MUSIC"

A former college football player, history teacher and high school basketball and baseball coach, George Lindsey played the comedy lead in the Broadway musical "All American" and also displayed his acting talent on nearly 50 television programs including "Gunsmoke", "Alfred Hitchcock Presents," and "Love American Style." Gunilla Hutton, who currently records on the Dot label, is one of the most promising vocalists on the country music circuit, however, her background includes a 9 month stint on the road with Nat King Cole as a singer and dancer, and a gig with Jack Benny in Las Vegas. Her first television series role was that of "Billie Jo" on "Petticoat Junction" followed by "Nurse Goodbody" on "Hee Haw." Her theatrical credits include the leading role in the Las Vegas production of "That Certain Girl" which did a six month run.
