Ronald Reagan, seeking the Republican nomination for President, told the LAS VEGAS ISRAELITE in an exclusive interview, he will never pressure Israel to force a settlement in the Middle East, but would do everything in his power to bring the Jews and Arabs to the negotiating table.

Reagan said he will not recognize the Pales-tine Liberation Organization until the PLO re-cognizes Israel as a country with the right to exist.

When asked, the front - running G.O.P. contender replied: "Israel is not Expendable,"

After carefully considering all pros and cons for the Republican nomination, we have deter-mined that for American Jews Ronald Reagan is a better choice as contender for the Presidency than Gerald Ford.

We are thoroughly distillusioned by the broken promises of Ford and his Secretary of State Kissinger. All their words of assurance they will not let Israel down, is not in keeping with their actions of support for Egypt, indifference for Labanon pressure on the Lewish difference for Lebanon, pressure on the Jewish state and withholding of aid.

So we sought out and spoke with Sen. Paul Laxalt, chairman of national citizens committee for Reagan.

Reagan is a severe critic of "detente" as a one-way street, just as we are. Reagan accused Kissinger of being more concerned with "detente" than the pouring of Russian with "detente" than the pouring of Russian arms to Egypt to launch a surprise attack against Israel in 1973.

Reagan advocates a peaceful settlement in the Middle East, with a warning that the future of Israel must be insured.
