

# JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Three terrorists were killed by an Israeli patrol after they tried to infiltrate into Israel from across the Jordan River.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- ABS Worldwide Technical Services, Inc., a division of the American Bureau Shipping has agreed to pay a total of \$10,500 to two American Jews who have charged the division with discriminating against them when they applied "for engineering posts with ABS operations in Arab countries."

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israel will not agree to any new conditions in return for a Syrian agreement to renew the mandate of the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force on the Golan Heights, Foreign Minister Yigal Allon stressed to the Cabinet.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The Israel Aliya Center here has reported that aliya from North America increased 28 percent in the first quarter of 1976, reversing the downward trend since the Yom Kippur War.

PHILADELPHIA (WNS) -- A Bicentennial commemoration of religious liberty, held under the auspices of B'nai B'rith, was attended by Jews and non-Jews to mark the rededication of the statue of religious liberty, a public monument by the Jewish sculptor, Moses Ezekiel, which B'nai B'rith had commissioned and presented 100 years ago as a gift to the nation during America's Centennial celebration.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- A 17-year-old Arab girl was fatally wounded and two Arab youths injured in a clash between Arab students and Israeli soldiers in Nablus during the latest outburst of disturbances on the West Bank.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Rep. Joshua A. Filberg (D, Pa.) has announced that the State Department will terminate within six months its 20-year policy of granting diplomatic visas to students from Kuwait and Saudi Arabia who are studying in the United States.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Labor Party Secretary General Meir Zarmi has reportedly been trying to bring about a rapprochement between Premier Yitzhak Rabin and Defense Minister Shimon Peres who have been clashing more openly.

PHILADELPHIA (WNS) -- The Democratic and Republican parties have been urged by B'nai B'rith to adopt planks in their 1976 Presidential platforms giving "forthright and unambiguous" support for federal legislation making it illegal for American firms to comply with the Arab boycott against Israel.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Four tons of emergency supplies for the earthquake victims in northern Italy have been sent by Israel's Red Magen David.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- While wages went up 36 percent in Israel last year, price rose 39 percent, according to the Central Bureau of Statistics.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israel will continue to demand that a fitting memorial be held at the Montreal Olympics in memory of the 11 Israeli athletes killed at the Munich games four years ago.

### FRENCH LEADER WARNS OF U.S. PRESSURES

PARIS (WNS) -- Israel must come up with a "credible" peace initiative or face an imposed solution after the elections in the United States, according to former Premier Pierre Mendes-France, who recently returned from a visit to Israel.

He warned that such a solution could be a new Munich. He said that no solution could be reached in the Middle East conflict unless "the Palestinians have a country and to decide on what con-

cerns them without any foreign intervention." Mendes-France criticized the Arabs for calling for Israel's destruction and Israel for establishing settlements in Arab territory.

He predicted that once the Lebanese crisis is over and the U.S. election is decided, Israel will be pressured for concessions. "This is why I hope with all my strength that Israel will take the initiative to avoid a new Munich."
