

The Aladdin, celebrating the completion of its \$60 million expansion program, lays claim to being the "Bicentennial-Hotel-of-the-Year." No

This striking new tower, reflecting the desert sun at dusk, glows like a giant golden statue. Few would argue that it is a magnificent addition to

the Las Vegas skyline.
In economic terms, the Aladdin, emerging with 1030 rooms, suites and luxury suites (including the penthouse suites which rent for \$1,500 per day), helpd bring the local room count to shout 35,000 first - rate rooms when the 200 top motels are included. Maybe that's why the local chamber of commerce claims that Las Vegas is on its way to being the nation's leading resortconvention-meeting area.

The traffic count here in Gambleville long ago passed the 10 - million annual tourist mark McCarran International Airport has challenged the 6 million enplane-deplane number this year and continues its annual flight - to - glory with 15 - to - 20 percent annual increases. In an enterview with the Jewish News of Detroit he faulted Secretary of State Henry A. Kissinger for not having ex-tracted a concession for direct negotia-tions from Egyptian President Anwar Sa-dat. Udall said that Kissinger has "gone as far as we can" with step - by - s negotiations and doubts there can separate settlements with Egypt and Syria.

Udall, supporter of the Jack-son Amendment, said it did not work because its implementing procedures humi-lated the Russians. "Once the dust has settled, we can go back to the Russians and resolve some of those problems," he said. Why Jews for Reagan?

The LAS VEGAS ISRAELITE is not alone among American Jews in seeking to stop President Gerald Ford from succeeding himself in office. The first step is to get Governor Ronald Reagan nominated by Republicans.

The consequences of where Ford and Kissinger are leading us, are terrifying. They are gambling with the future of Israel. The slow influx of propaganda, financed by Arab oil money, but en-hanced by the administration has turned loyal Americans, sympathetic to the Israeli cause,

away from the Jewish State.
