



Dear Mike (Tell):

It was good seeing and chatting with you this past month on the flight to Reno. This letter comes pursuant to your request for information on my voting record vis a vis lsrael.

I have strongly supported aid to Israel in the past and will continue to do so in the future

Last March I successfully opposed efforts to delete \$200 million from a \$1.5 billion arms credits package for Israel. With my support the \$1.5 billion in appropriations were ulti-mately approved. Also last March I supported mately approved. \$1.6 billion in military aid for Israel.

Last year I co-sponsored the resolution condemning the United Nations for their ef-forts to equate "zionism" with "racism." I also supported U.S. participation in the Sinai accord, which provided over \$3 billion in mili-tary and economic aid to Israel.

I also co-sponsored legislation giving Is-rael F-15 fighter planes, electronic counter-measures, and other sophisticated weapons nec-essary to insure the continued military viability of Israel.

I am quite proud of my voting record and posi-tions taken in favor of Israel. If I can be of any further assistance to you, Mike, please do let me know.
