## NO INTERVENTION INTO LEBANON BY ISRAEL IF NORTH BORDER SAFE

### ISRAEL REJECTS UN REPORT, MATCH

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- The report by the Special Committee on the Exercise of the Inalienable Rights of the Palestinian People to the Security Council has been rejected by Israel as a Palestine Liberation Organization solution to the Middle

East problem. Herzog said Israel "rejects outright" the report just as it rejected the creation of the 20-member committee by the General Assembly last year. Herzog noted that 16 out of the 20 members of the committee do not have diplomatic relations with Israel and "not a single free country of standing agreed to take part in the work of the committee, so utterly prejudiced was it considered to be." He charged that "The PLO was dominant in drafting of the committee's report and in keeping with the PLO's declared aim."

The committee report calls for Israel to withdraw unconditionally from the West Bank, Gaza Strip and East Jerusalem within one year. Palestinians would then return to those areas under UN jurisdiction to be followed by a PLO takeover

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Israel's decision on whether to act on the situation in Lebanon will be determined by its national interest, according to Foreign Minister Yigal Allon.

He made this statement at a press conference following reports that additional Syrian troops have entered the strife-torn Arab country. Allon noted that Syria and "all other relevant parties" know what constitutes Israel's "red line," the point at which Israel might intervene in Lebanon. Israeli officials have not publicly defined the "red line", but Allon told the newsmen that the line was not necessarily a geographic point.

Later, Defense Minister Shimon Peres said that if Israel were to intervene in Lebanon it could be interpreted as Israeli support for Palestine Liberation Organization leader Yasir Arafat. He explained that although Syria originally intervened to strengthen the PLO and the Moslem community, it is now supporting the Christian faction in the Civil War. Peres described the Syrian move as an effort to achieve a ceasefire rather than a takeover of Lebanon.

Israel is watching the situation closely and stressed that its main interest is the safety of the northern borders. It is assumed that if the Syrians concentrate their activities north of the Litani River, thus keeping out of the areas closest to Israel, there would be no cause for any Israeli action.
