## GEN. GUR WARNS WARRING ARABS AGAINST TURNING ON ISRAEL LATER

### MADALYN CHICK BAT MITZVAH

Madalyn Chick, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Irving Chick, will recite a portion of the Haftorah and become a Bat Mitzvah during services at Temple Beth Shalom, on Friday evening, June 18, 1976.

Rabbi Philip Shnairson, spiritual leader of the Temple, will officiate and conduct the services which commence at 8:00 P.M. Cantor Joseph Kohn will chant the liturgy.

The parents of the Bat Mitzvah will host the congrega-

tion to Oneg Shabbat refreshments in the Entratter Social Hall immediately after the conclusion of the services.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Gen. Mordechai Gur, Israel's Chief of Staff, warned the Syrians and Palestinians who are presently fighting each other in Lebanon against turning on Israel when that crisis is over.

He said the terrorists in particular may have become encouraged by their success against Syrian regular troops. "Let them not be mistaken, when the Israeli army fights it is not like the Syrians, it fights to win," Gur warned. His remarks came as the Israeli government was closely watching the Lebanese situation. Some concern was raised by the decision of the Arab League to send a pan-Arab force into Lebanon where the Syrians are attempting to win a decisive victory over forces of the Palestine Liberation Organization.

Israel meanwhile has reported clashes between the PLO and the Syrian-backed Al Sajaqa terrorist units in Southern Lebanon. The reports have come from Lebanese villagers who have come to the border to receive medical aid from Israel. Israeli ambulances and medical corpsmen have been stationed at the border posts for that purpose.

The Syrian intervention in Lebanon has been denounced by West Bank Arabs as a pretext to destroy the PLO. Israeli security forces used tear gas to dispel rock-throwing, tire-burning Arab youths in Nablus who were protesting against Syria. West Bank mayors, town coun-

### Crazy World

The whole world has gone crazy -- or maybe it has always been that way and we're just finding out about it.

Ten to fifteen years ago when the teenagers were rebelling against the establishment, we regarded them as a natural product of the generation after World War 2. It always happened before after a major conflict. But this time it was different. A couple of other wars had popped up, heightening the intensity to prolong the boiling point of emotions for young men and women. They screamed for change, change change. And now we know they were so right, right, right.

It took Watergate to set the tempo. But we're finding out it was just the tip of the iceberg. Incredible goings-on have already been unearthed. We positively shudder at what may unravel in the near future. Unbelievable items are coming out about the F.B.I., the C.I.A., and other heretofore untouchable institutions. How did they ever sink to such low depths? Where were the patriotic, dedicated Americans in government service who allowed this display of dissipation?

We were brought up in an era of pleasurable astonishment at Ripley's Believe It or Not, or wonderment of stories about truth being stranger than fiction. They were unusual happenstances that were odd but amusing, or mysterious but droll, or rare but innocuous.

What is being revealed today is nothing more than stark, raving stupidity. In all probability it had been going on in the past, maybe for a long, long time. That is why we feel so let down. We did not know, or even suspect. And if it were shown to us in black and white, we would not have believed it. How wrong we were.

You see, our faith in the American democratic system, and our trust in our elected leaders, was so strong it had no bounds. Surely there were sharp controversies, where one side was eventually proven wrong, but we chalked those incidences up to honest differences of opinion. We chuckled at the story of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, every Friday in the front row of Washington burlesque theatre. He was human and entitled. We loved President Kennedy's inaugural speech reverence. "I hope my mistakes are little ones." We made allowances for the bad apple that showed up every now and then.

But the bad apples are prevalent today. It looks like Congress is on a wholesale sex

### NEW ON FORMULA TO "DESTROY ISRAEL"

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- Chaim Herzog, Israel's Ambassador to the United Nations, has labelled the report by the Committee on the Exercise of the Inalienable Rights of the Palestinian people as "a

calculated formula for the destruction of Israel."

His remarks were made at a press conference as the Security Council began a debate on the report. Herzog reiterated Israel's refusal to participate in the debate. He stressed that the problem of the Palestinian identity "will most certainly" be dealt with at the Geneva peace conference and declared that "Israel for its part will not agree to any settlement which does not give adequate expression to this identity."

He declared that a Middle East solution can be reached only on the basis of Security Council Resolutions 242 and 338 and at the Geneva Conference. At the Security Council meeting, Senegalese Ambassador Medoune Fall, who is chairman of the special committee, said that "the violation of the inalienable rights of the Palestinian people" is at the center of the conflict in the Middle East.
