## TARDUST HOTEL \$70,000,000 EXPANSION

The first phases of a \$70 million Stardust expansion and renovation program will be completed in early July, Argent Corporation President and Chairman of the Board Allen R. Glick announced.

The massive building project will in-clude a complete \$3,5 million casino overhaul -- more than doubling its previous size -- a brand new \$1.6 million race and sports book, a \$1.5 million frontal facelift, a 650 seat casino lounge, an expanded remodeled 600sear coffee shop, and eventually, a 1,000room high rise addi-

Glick said all plans were finalized, except for the high rise. The financial arrangements for that phase, he said, are still still being negotiated.

But already, much of the mammoth casino expansion is nearing completion. And when all is said and done, the Stardust will boast the largest gaming area largest gaming area in the world -- more than 70,000 sq. ft, of casino space.

Glick said the Stardust will build a 650-seat casino lounge that will feature dusk till dawn entertainment. The new entertainment nment lounge measure more will. than 9,000 sq. ft. in area, and will feature a revolving stage replete with the latest in technical sound and

lighting equipment.

Glick said the new lounge facility will cost nearly threequarters of a million dollars. It is scheduled for completion in mid-September or October
