Rockefeller Lands Jews

Vice President Nelson Rockefeller, donning a kippah and flanked by rabbis, lauded Jews for their participation and contribution in the building of our nation.

The occasion was the Bicentennial of the American Revolution and the Jubilee Anniversary of the Synagogue Council of America. The colorful setting was the Touro Synagogue in Newport, Rhode Island, the oldest Jewish House of Worship in the United States.

Mr. Rockefeller told the 250 invited guests that the Jewish experience in America is a "particularly vivid illustration of opportunity for the individual being translated into betterment for all."

He added that we couldn't subtract the Jewish contribution from American life "without impoverishing our science, our literature, our art, our commerce, our law -- indeed, without vastly diminishing America."

"The Jewish contribution to the American experience is beyond calculation -- and out of all proportion to the numbers of Jewish Americans involved."

The Vice President also said that the spiritual and religious forces which inspired our founding fathers, shaped life in America from its very beginnings. "These forces inspired the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United States," he said. "And, most important, these spiritual and religious forces have continued to shape the American character to this day, a character dominated by such qualities as respect for the dignity of the individual, kindness, generosity, neighborliness, equality of opportunity, equality before the law, a restless energy, a willingness to take risks, and faith, hope and love. The contributions of America to religious freedom are as monumental as its contributions to political liberty and to economic freedom."

Rockefeller emphasized that today, the basic principles of America's founding and its growth -- its dedication to human dignity and the spiritual nature of man, its trust in free individuals taking responsibility for their actions, are being seriously challenged.

"Totalitarian socialist societies have developed, which ignore the concept of man as a spiritual human being," he said. "They repress personal liberty and they forbid religious freedom. They deny individual economic freedom."

"In the present world, centrally - controlled,

Marxist power is on the march throughout the world, supported by subversion, so-called wars of liberation and growing military power.

"Unfortunately, in this period, we have seen some striking failures of moral example both in public and private life here at home," he continued. "This can be dangerous. Uncorrected, it can weaken the moral fiber of our society."

The Vice President warned that each American must return to the basic concepts of individual responsibility for his own acts, upon which our society was founded.

"The teachings of Judaism are based on a moral vision of mankind -- on a reverence for individual uniqueness and individual dignity," he remarked. "Judaism also teaches that individual dignity and freedom must be accompanied by an acceptance of moral responsibility on the part of the individual. These convictions are so much in keeping with moral philosophy of our Nation's founding fathers that it is hardly surprising that Jewish Americans have made such an enormous contribution to America's emergence as the greatest, freest Nation on earth."

He told the audience, representing a cross section of American Jewry that America is grateful for "your spiritual heritage and for those priceless contributions."

"What those who worshipped here in Touro Synagogue heard in 1776, what all Americans heard in that fateful year, still rings with relevance today," Rockefeller concluded. "The men of the Revolution declared their commitment to human dignity in these unforgettable words:

"With a firm reliance on the Protection of divine Providence we mutually pledge to each other our lives, our fortunes and our sacred honor."

"Dare we do less today? I think not."

FORD OPPOSES NEW ARAB BOYCOTT CURB LAWS

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The Ford Administration continues to oppose additional legislation to curb the Arab boycott of Israel.

"No additional legislation is necessary or desirable at this time," Treasury Secretary William Simon told the House International Relations Committee. He said new laws "would be detrimental to the totality of United States interests both here and in the Middle East."

Simon stressed that the Administration has talked with Arabs and Israelis as well as American Jews on ways to eliminate discriminatory practices. "We have made the point that our basic goal must be to encourage progress toward peace," he said. "It is in our considered judgement that confrontational policies will not move to remove the boycott and could undermine the delicate search for peace in that troubled region of the world."

But Will Maslow, general counsel of the American Jewish Congress, and Seymour Graubard, chairman of the B'nai B'rith Anti-Defamation League, told the Committee that voluntary action against the boycott has failed. They said that some businessmen would like strong governmental laws to help them stand up against the boycott.

In testimony before the House Governmental Operations Subcommittee, Dr. Arthur F. Burns, chairman of the Federal Reserve Board, said that American banks play a major role in giving effect to the boycott in the U.S. He said if diplomatic action fails then Congress should act to control the problem. Rauer Meyer, director of the Commerce Department's Office of Export Administration, testified that a department survey found 119 American banks received 10,443 restrictive requests covering 5190 transactions during a four-month period. He said that in only 72 cases, in each of the months, did the banks refuse to process letters of credit or otherwise participate in the boycott. Rep. Benjamin S. Rosenthal (D.
