More than 100 terror

More than 100 terror - stricken hostages under constant threat of death by PLO hijackers were rescued by Israeli commendos and flown 2,300 miles safely back to Tel Aviv. It was a daring half-hour, midnight strike into Uganda, where Pres. Idi Amin had given haven and protection to the hijackers of an Air France passenger plane boarded in Athens a week earlier. a week earlier.

All seven of the hijackers, and 20 Ugandan

All seven of the hijackers, and 20 Ugandan soldiers defending them, were killed by the commandos. An Israeli officer and three hostages died in the attack.

There were 254 passengers and crew on the plane bound from Tel Aviv to Paris, but all others had been released except those of Jewish descent and the crew. Ten Americans were

descent and the crew. Ten Americans were among those rescued by the Commandos.

The hostages were kept confined at the Uganda air terminal surrounded by boxes of dynamite.
The PLO had demanded release of iailed terrorists in return for freeing the hostages.

The Israeli commandos, some in civilian

clothes landed in passenger planes. They wasted little time in overcoming the hijackers, suc-cumbing the Uganda army men protecting the
