And, this time, co-starring with the famed vocalist is France's biggest contribution to the entertainment world, Michel Legrand, composer - singer winner of no less than two Oscars, three Grammys and an Emmy nomination.

Legrant, making his Las Vegas debut, without doubt is one of show business's most versatile talents.

Born in Paris, was a child prodigy at age 11. When he was 20 he was graduated from the Paris Conservatory with top honors in composition. Two years later, up-on request from Columbia Records, he arranged and conducted the album, "I Love Paris," which became one of the bestselling instrumental records ever released.
