District Judge Addeliar D. Guy Monday announced his candidacy for the Eighth Judicial District Court post, a posi-tion he has held since his 1975 appointment by Gov. Mike Callaghan.

Guy, 52, has served as judge of Juvenile Court since January. Last year 21,000 complaints vent through the court.

In his capacity as Juvenile Court judge, which he de-scribes as "the most challeng-ing I have ever had," he han-

dles rulings on any crime committed by a juvenile and over-sees foster homes and foster parents.

Prior to his appointment Judge Guy was the chief deputy district at-

torney.

In May, Guy was honored for his work on the bench.

He said the present juvenile detention facilities are "not only too small, they are generally inadequate for the case load
