

**DAYAN ACCUSES RABIN OF SPREADING DOUBT**

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Former Defense Minister Moshe Dayan has accused Premier Yitzhak Rabin's government of spreading "doubt and confusion" among Jews abroad.

In a radio interview Dayan also said the Syrian action in Lebanon is no threat to Israel and he strongly supported Jewish settlements on the West Bank. Dayan said Israel should not consider intervening until Syria's presence

poses a threat to Israeli security or unless the Lebanese Christian community specifically asked for help and offered to make peace with Israel.

He urged Israel to seek an end-of-war or non-belligerency agreements with Syria and Egypt through the United States. He said until this occurs Israel should act unilaterally in accordance with its final peace maps and urged the

establishment of more Jewish settlements on the West Bank, especially on the chain of hills running from Jerusalem to Nablus. He also said it was possible that Israel and Jordan could settle the Palestinian issue between them without formal peace talks. He noted that Jordanian King Hussein has announced plans to resettle a half million Palestinian refugees on the East Bank of the Jordan River and said Israel should try to get the U.S. and

European countries to help Jordan with this project. Dayan said if Israel provided housing for another 200,000 Palestinian refugees now in the Gaza Strip, the would-be Palestinian state would have been accommodated.

**UN SECURITY COUNCIL RIPS ISRAEL**

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- Security Council President Louis de Guiringaud read the council a majority statement deploring the establishment by Israel of settlements in the occupied territories as an "obstacle" to peace in the Middle East.

The statement, which expressed "grave anxiety" over the present situation in the territories and concern about the fate of the Arab population there, urged Israel "to desist and rescind" such measures. The statement which did not specify which of the 15 Council members approved it came at the end of a Council debate on a request by Egypt to criticize Israel's administration of the territories.

A draft resolution criticizing Israel was ruled out by the Council members because of the likelihood of an American veto. American objections also eliminated the possibility of a consensus statement which would have required the unanimous endorsement of all 15 Council members. U.S. Ambassador William Scranton also voiced objections to the majority statement as lacking balance.

However, he said there was much that the U.S. could agree with, noting that the Israeli settlements

"are increasingly a matter of concern and distress to its (Israel's) friends throughout the world and are not helpful to the process of peace."

Israeli Ambassador Chaim Herzog declared that "Israel rejects the thesis that the establishment of settlements is an obstacle to peace. We reject it out of hand." He said "the obstacle to peace is the Arab refusal to recognize the Jewish people's right to sovereignty in its ancient homeland."

**HADASSAH DEDICATES GUGGENHEIM PAVILLION**

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The \$7 million Daniel and Florence Guggenheim Rehabilitation Pavilion was dedicated by Hadassah at its Mt. Scopus Hospital.

The pavilion, which takes up the entire wing of the hospital has 60 beds and is equipped with the latest in rehabilitation equipment. The main donors of the funds for the building are the Guggenheim family in New York, who helped build the original Mt. Scopus Hospital, and 27,954 West German citizens, who contributed to a fund organized by Axel Springer, the German newspaper publisher and the Jerusalem Fund.
