

AFTERMATH OF BOLD ISRAELI 2,300 MILE RAID TO RESCUE 100 HOSTAGES

(CABLE TO ISRAELI LEADERS BY AMER. ZIONIST FEDERATION)

"One million American Zionists, six million American Jews and millions of Americans celebrating the July 4th Bicentennial weekend were stirred beyond description by the bold and daring rescue of the Israeli hostages held in captivity in Uganda. American Zionists, indeed all of American Jewry, and most Americans applaud this great moral and military triumph. Americans everywhere who cherish democracy and freedom identify with this act of heroism and compassion. Jews everywhere have reason to stand tall and proud, with thanks and praise for this miraculous rescue. We Zionists herald this great and historic rescue mission as but another proud page in Zionist history. Kol Ha-Kavod."

ZOA HOUSE, NEW YORK -- A telegram of thanks was sent to the President of the Republic of Kenya, Jomo Kenyatta, by the Zionist Organization of America, "heartfelt thanks for the humanitarian act of the Republic of Kenya on behalf of victims of terrorism."

Calling the rescue operation at Entebbe Airport in Uganda a "masterful stroke of logistical planning and daring," Esther R. Landa, National President of the National Council of Jewish Women (NCJW), stated that it was an irony that the rest of the world was intimidated into private admiration and public condemnation for a mission which should not have been necessary, had the UN exercised its rightful responsible role among the nations of the world.

"The United Nations," Mrs. Landa said, "has been derelict in acting decisively in matters which do

fall within its proper purview, such as the problem of international terrorism and hijacking. If the UN had fulfilled its mandate, there might have been no need for the State of Israel to act to rescue the passengers and crew from kidnapping and possible death."

NCJW sent a message of appreciation to President Ford praising the United States Government for responding promptly with congratulations to Israel on the successful air rescue.

ZOA HOUSE, N. Y. -- In a series of telegrams addressed to President Gerald Ford, Secretary of State Henry Kissinger and the United States Representative to the United Nations, William Scranton, the President of the Zionist Organization of America, Rabbi Joseph P. Sternstein, accused United Nations Secretary General, Kurt Waldheim, of personal bias against Israel. Rabbi Sternstein, basing his comments on a United Nations Office of Public Information confirmation that Waldheim had indeed charged Israel with the violation of the sovereignty of a member state, accused Waldheim of "permitting his personal bias to judge Israel in an improper way. Furthermore," Sternstein added, "his public statements constitute a serious breach of his office and are an affront to all who see the courageous action of Israel as a move in the defense of world morality."

Rabbi Sternstein urged the United States delegation "to immediately make known its rejection of this shocking conclusion and publicly remind the Secretary General that it is the Security Council which has the responsibility for making such conclusions, and" he add-
