RABIN WARNS OF CONFRONTATION WITH U.S.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Premier Yitzhak Rabin has issued a second warning of the possibility of a confrontation with the United States after the November Presidential election.

He told the Labor Party Knesset faction that historically the U.S. and Israel agree on interim agreements but disagree on the nature of a general Middle East settlement. He said that he expects the U. S. to press for a settlement that calls for a complete Israeli withdrawal from the occupied territories except for minor boundary modifications.
