

**SCHOLARSHIP FUND ESTABLISHED**

NEW YORK (WNS) -- A donation of \$12,500 has been announced by Abraham Feinberg, prominent American financier and philanthropist for the establishment of a scholarship fund for children of Israeli soldiers who heroically died in combat for the release of

hostages in Uganda and other battles against Arab aggression. In announcing his donation, Feinberg, who is board chairman of the American Bank & Trust Co., said that "no words can express the gratitude of the civilized world to those brave men

who freed their kinsmen and others condemned to the will of a fanatical gang, aided by a ruthless dictator, whose lack of human qualities has often been demonstrated before. In offering this token of appreciation to the participants in this rescue operation for the educational benefits of the children of their comrades who fell in this engagement, and on all too many previous battlefields against Arab terrorism, I hope others will follow."

Meanwhile, listeners of the Hebrew-language program "Kan Israel" (here is Israel) over New York radio station WEVD sent \$7,020 for a special fund established in Israel to help out with the expenses to the Israeli government of the rescue operation in Uganda.

**MOYNIHAN: ISRAEL A "METAPHOR FOR DEMOCRACY"**

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Daniel P. Moynihan, the former United States Ambassador to the United Nations, declared here that Israel has become a metaphor for democracy in the world. He added that "so, equally, have the utterly unprincipled attacks by terrorists on Israeli civilians become a metaphor for the general assault on democracy and decency."

Moynihan's remarks came as he received an honorary degree from Hebrew University. Also receiving an honorary degree was Andrei D. Sakharov, the Soviet physicist and leading dissident, who was not allowed to come to Israel for the award. Moynihan said this was another example of the Soviet Leaders' determination to oppose the freedom of man. Moynihan stressed that there is a danger
