Lebanon's Civil War Reveals UN Camps As PLO Bases

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- The truth is out at last!

The bloody civil war in Lebanon has revealed to the whole world what the Israelis have been stating for many years, namely, that the Arab refugee camps in Lebanon, sustained and funded by UNRWA, have been PLO training camps for terrorists aimed at the destruction of Israel, the hijacking of planes and the murder of innocent civilians, Jews and non-Jews.

For years, the PLO gunmen, 'protected' under the umbrella of the UN, had been training youngsters in these camps for guerrilla warfare instilling in them murderous hate of Jews and of all those in the world who supported the Jewish State. And although this fact was generally known, the world organization did nothing about it.

Of all UN Member States, Israel alone spoke out and also acted. Following Ma'alot, Kiryat Shemonah and other terrorist atrocities perpetrated from Arafat's Fatahland, the Israelis retaliated against these fortress camps inflicting heavy damages -- certainly not as devastating as those which are now being inflicted upon them with such severity by the Christian Phalangists.

And while the UN remains silent now on the blood that is being shed in that unfortunate country, in the past it always found it expedient to condemn the Israelis for their defensive retaliations against the murderers. Lebanon has now proved that the Israelis did the right thing. For the true nature of the PLO has now been bared for all mankind to see. ese have thus paid dearly for the hospitality their nation has given to the Palestinian terrorists permitting them to dominate the refugee camps which they transformed into military bases from which they have now assaulted their naive hosts.

As an Israeli official of the Foreign Ministry noted recently, "Having been given a room, the PLO attempted to take over the entire house." In this attempt, fortunately, they have failed.

And we ask, in the light of the Lebanese tragedy, how can the UN, under Soviet, Arab and nonaligned nations' pressure, still insist upon granting a "room" (the West Bank) in Samaria -- in the very heart of Israel -- to the PLO terrorists responsible for the disintegration of an Arab State?

We pose this question because everyone here at the UN is fully aware of the fact that Arafat's avowed aim is to replace Israel with a so-called "secular democratic state." In simpler words, once given a "room" he will attempt to take over the entire "house."

The Lebanese have now learned -- somewhat late -- that the PLO is a parasitic growth that spreads like cancer. Nihilistic in nature, it could not exist within the context of Lebanese democracy, the only one of its kind in the Arab world. Arafat had to destroy this democracy by exploiting and fanning religious conflict between the sensitively balanced Moslem and Christian communities, plunging them into bitter fratricidal conflict.

It is against this background that an appraisal of the PLO, as a menace to the Middle East, must be made. It has until now been permitted to follow its lethal course regardless of the price and consequences. It is answerable to no responsible body, no elected assembly. At no time has it received a mandate from the Palestinian Arab people in whose name it has wrought such death and havoc. Its backing has come from the Arab states at Rabat and from the blasphemous resolutions of the UN and its subsidiaries.

Historically, the PLO's lineage can be traced directly back to the Palestinian terrorist movement of the notorious Haj Amin el-Husseini, the Mufti of Jerusalem, who brought so much disaster to the Palestinian Arabs between 1936-39. He brought about the death of thousands of Arabs who opposed his fanatical and genocidal role at that time. By his allegiance to Hitler in World War II, he set the pattern which Yasir Arafat has since followed. Arafat is not merely the Mufti's relative, through his mother; he is also his most orthodox disciple in terror and in pervasive political goals.

What is happening in Lebanon is bound to affect all issues touching upon the entire Middle East here at the UN. First of all, the tragedy poses a very cogent question to all those delegations, among them a number of Western states, who have given the PLO credibility and recogni-

tion, namely, to what extent do they bear at least partial responsibility for what Arafat's gunmen have done to Lebanon and to the Palestinians? It is entirely possible that some of the non-aligned states will revise their estimate of the PLO in terms of the true interests of the Palestinians, of Israel and of Middle East peace.

The Lebanese tragedy has also placed the pro-PLO Soviets in a somewhat awkward position. Not wanting to alienate the Syrians for their intervention in Lebanon against the PLO-Leftist coalition, they have been extra-cautious in their official statements commenting on the crisis. In a press statement just released here at the UN, they say that "the current crisis began with attacks on the Palestinians" without mentioning Damascus' role in these attacks. They note further that "it was imperialist interference that worsened the situation."

In referring to "the unsuccessful actions of the Arab League" to bring about a cease-fire, they say that "this is due above all to contradictions which exist in the Arab world. It is not a secret," they add, "that after the signing of the Sinai agreement, concluded by Egypt and Israel, the differences between Arab countries have grown and the mistrust and suspicion of one government in respect to another have intensified..."

The Lebanese inferno has borne out one basic fact, and that is that the PLO is as much the enemy of the Palestinian Arabs as it is of Israel and this truth is being brought home to the hard-working Arabs residing in the West Bank and the Gaza Strip.

American - Jewish history was recently made near Valley Forge, Penna.

For the first time a Jew was elected president of the Military Chaplains Association.

At its 51st annual gathering, the association, comprising clergymen who serve or who have served in uniform elevated Rabbi Simeon Kobrinetz to its No. 1 spot.

A graduate of the Jewish Theological Seminary, the rabbi is also the youngest man ever to head the organization.

The association is truly ecumenical, comprising ministers of all faiths also from all over the world who have served in the U.S. as military ministers.

Several hundred of the clergymen gave Rabbi Kobrinetz a standing ovation at their convocation. The night he was installed was also the same night the association conferred its annual citizenship Award to President Ford.

In his inaugural address, the new president called for clergymen truly to proclaim freedom by speaking out boldly on the moral issues of our day.

From 9 to 5, Rabbi Kobrinetz is on Uncle Sam's payroll in a most important and lofty post: deputy national chaplain of the Veterans Administration.

The election of the first rabbi as head of the Military Chaplains Association is like a bi-centennial gift by the U.S. to the American Jewish community.
