

1973. The court is persuaded by the re-cord that the "wearing of beards, although required, is a well-established religious tradition among members of the Jew-ish faith," Robinson said. He said Geller "wore his beard in furtherance of that re-ligious practice."

Geller testified that when he joined the Air Force in 1950 he did not have a beard but that after his father's death in 1966 he felt a personal obligation to wear one. He was not challenged for six but then the years, commander of the Westover Air Force Base in Massachusetts ordered him to shave off the beard and when he refused he was reassigned to inactive reserve status.
