BEARDED RABBI REINSTATED TO AIR FORCE

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- A U. S. District Court Judge has ordered the Air Force to reinstate an Orthodox rabbi to his former status as an active reserve chaplain from which he was re-

assigned because he has a beard. Judge Aubrey E. Robinson, Jr. also said the Air Force should give Lt. Col. Mitchell D. Geller all promotions due him since 1972 and back pay since

1973. The court is persuaded by the record that the "wearing of beards, although not required, is a well-established religious tradition among members of the Jewish faith," Robinson said. He said Geller "wore his beard in furtherance of that religious practice."

Geller testified that when he joined the Air Force in 1950 he did not have a beard but that after his father's death in 1966 he felt a personal obligation to wear one. He was not challenged for six years, but then the commander of the Westover Air Force Base in Massachusetts ordered him to shave off the beard and when he refused he was reassigned to inactive reserve status.
