'One Man Plus The Truth

Constitutes A Majority"

Not enough can be told and re-told of the daring 2,300 - mile rescue by Israeli commandos of more than 100 hostages facing almost certain

of more than 100 hostages facing almost certain death by terrorists in a hostile country. The official report is sealed under lock and key for 25 years, it has been declared by the government of Israel. But a Bantam paperbook, '90 Minutes at Entebbe,'' written with incredible detail and astonishing speed by William Steven-son, reveals previously unreported details that will dumbfound the most sophisticated reader. We are told that three terrorists were taken

We are told that three terrorists were taken alive back to Israel for interrogation after the remaining seven were killed and their fingerprints and photographs recorded.

From newspaper reports, one would surmise it was a hap-hazard, hastily put together opera-tion as a last desperate move to free the Jewish victims. It was no such thing. Time was im-portant, true. A speedy determination to act was paramount, no question about it with 100 lives

at stake. But the planning of this midnight daring raid will probably go down as the best conceived and most thoroughly blueprinted maneuver in mili-tary tactics of all time. In a few short days the Israeli Task Force that planned the mission accumulated tons of information from sources all over the world, from morsels to mountains, to protect against every possible and conceivable hazard.

A highly - developed form of hypnoses was used on a previously released hostage to reveal details on the layout of the airport and the exact location of the remaining hostages. What could not be remembered by a man in full conscience was revealed by the sub-conscious under the spell. Like how many doors there were in the building and did the windows open in or out. Three days before the raid an intelligence

group of 50 Israeli agents, disguised as businessmen, flew to Nairobi, Kenya, to scan and scout the planned operation. They set up headquarters at the private home of an Israeli trader and fanned the whole territory for every morsel that could be of consequence.

In Stevenson's book, the mission's planning and preparations, intricately carried out in total secrecy, are seen through the eyes of Brig. Gen. Dan Shomron, who was in charge of the operation, and Defense Minister Shimon Peres. It is literature of stark, naked realism, spell-binding the reader from page to page, even (Continued on Page 4)
