

ISRAEL'S MAGEN DAVID ADOM SAVES LEBANESE

Against the background of the successful "open fence" policy practice by Israel in providing free medical care for Christian and Moslem victims from war-torn Lebanon, the fact that International Red Cross still refuses to grant recognition to Israel's Magen David Adom (Red Shield of David) Society has stirred up new resentment all over the world.

Rabbi Rubin R. Dobin, National Co-Chairman of OPERATION RECOGNITION, which is spearheading a campaign for Magen David Adom acceptance, pointed out that in the past 3 months more than 3,000 sick and wounded Lebanese have been treated at the Israel border. Frontier tent clinics have been set up with facilities maintained by Israeli doctors who have been called up by the Army for reserve duty. The Israel Magen David Adom Society provides all the important familiar Red Cross services at these frontier installations in cooperation with the

Army Medical Corps. It was reported that close to 400 Lebanese apply for treatment every day with about 100 of the more serious sick and wounded already admitted to Israeli hospitals for extended treatment.

Rabbi Dobin pointed out that although the International Red Cross recognizes the Christian Red Cross, the Moslem Red Crescent, and the Red Lion and Sun of Iran, it has thus far refused to recognize the Red Shield of David (Magen David Adom) of Israel.

Senators Jacob Javits and Abraham Ribicoff serve as National Co-Chairmen of OPERATION RECOGNITION and it was expected that the recently held Diplomatic Conference at Geneva would take up the matter of Magen David Adom recognition and will see to it that the International Red Cross would grant full acceptance as a humanitarian symbol.
