NICK HORN FOR ASSEMBLY 15

Nick Horn, who heads the Business Department at the Clark County Community College, announces his candidacy for the democratic nomination for State Assembly District 15.

Horn, 31, who co-ordinated the Busi-

ness, Management, Real Estate and Money and Banking programs at the college, is also a licensed business management consultant specializing in small businesses, marketing studies and polling. He has also taught graduate courses in the Masters

of Business Administration program at Nellis Air Force Base. A college graduate, Horn also has a Masters of Public Administration degree from the Institute of Government Service at Brigham Young University.

Horn said the rising crime rate, citizen confidence in elected officials and meeting capital and social needs on a balanced budget are among the central issues of the 1976 campaign. "I believe that everything we do in state government should address one question: 'Does it enhance, enrich, safeguard and insure a better life for us and our families?' This is the theme I intend to take into this campaign.

"Representative government demands that the peoples' views be heard and their thinking represented. This is one of the primary roles of an assemblyman," Horn said.

"My position on many of the issues and questions which affect the quality of our lives will be formulated directly by my constituents. I intend to periodically send out 'citizen questionnaires' which will

measure the attitude of the voters of District 15, so that I can accurately reflect the wishes of the people, work to solve their concerns, and provide responsible representation.

He said the issues of: crime control; mandatory sentences for certain categories of crimes; tougher and clearer rape legislation; a stronger mobile home owner's bill of rights; the growing study of solar energy; malpractice insurance; and tax reform, including the abolishment of the sales tax on food, are very

important since they influence the development and preservation of the life we enjoy in Nevada.
